## Grading/Attendance Policy for 6th Grade Math

#### Grading:

Math grades are based on total points. Classwork assignments are graded on completion and students receive 10 points for **completed** assignments. Tests, quizzes, and "homework checks" are strictly based on points and at times partial credit may be awarded for problems that are partially correct. For example, if a problem is worth 2 points and part of the work is correct, the student can receive 1 point. IXL will range from 10 to 0 points based on the breakdown below.

IXL Grading Breakdown - IXL scores will range from 10 to 0. Students will only receive a 0 if IXL lessons are not completed. Scores will be out of a possible 8 points. Students can earn extra credit if their Smart Score is above 89.

I will take into consideration time spent on IXL compared to Smart Score.

Homework may include a "Homework Check", which will be a Google Form with questions directly from the homework assignment and/or class notes. These assignments will be worth various points depending on the amount of questions. Students may use their notes/book/assignment on the homework checks. Homework checks will always be assigned after assignments are corrected and discussed. If your child is absent when an assignment is corrected, it is their responsibility to see me to get the correct answers.

Homework assignments will be assigned, but may not necessarily be graded or entered into Aeries.

\* I do not want students to be spending hours on math assignments. If your child has worked diligently on the assignment, but they have not completed the assigned problems, please sign the top of the page and they will receive full credit for that assignment..

Students will have opportunities to improve their grades by completing test/quiz corrections or having opportunities to retake a test/quiz. Students will be able to earn up to half the points they missed on the test. Students may make corrections if they miss one or all problems on a test.

I urge you to stay informed of your child's grade on Aeries.

Your child's grade is based on the assignments they complete, IXL, as well as tests and quizzes. The percentage breakdown is as follows:

- An incomplete assignment will be automatically half credit or 5 points
- Missing assignments will start as a 0 but given full credit upon completion
- Missing work must be completed within two(2) weeks after the grade has been entered into Airies to receive full credit. After the two weeks, the assignment will be considered late.
- Late assignments will start as a 0 but given half credit(5 points) upon completion.

# Sports/extracurricular activities are not a valid excuse for not having assignments completed.

End of semester grades - I will raise any percent ending in 9 to the next letter grade(59%, 69%, 79%, or 89%) as long as the student has no more than a total of two(2) late or incomplete assignments, has taken advantage of completing test corrections, and has been consistently working on IXL.

**Cheating/Copying:** Copying and/or "googling" questions is considered cheating. Any student caught copying another student's work or "googling" questions on homework, quizzes, or tests will automatically receive a 0 on that assignment without the opportunity to make it up. In the case of copying, all students involved will receive a 0 on that assignment, quiz, or test. Repeated offenses will also result in a detention.
