3.1 Tables

Table numbering starts from 1 onward and is not linked to chapters or sub-sections (e.g., Table 1, not Table 3.1). Table titles use capitalization at the beginning of each word. The table and its title are centered, and the title is placed above the table.

Tables use horizontal lines without vertical lines. Tables are created without color. Table labels are bold. If a table is wide, it may use a single column. Tables must be “in line with text” and must not float above the text, so that when editing (e.g., pressing Enter), the table moves accordingly.

When referring to a table, do not use “above” (e.g., “in the table above”); instead, refer directly to the table number (e.g., “in Table 1”).

3.2 Figures and Charts

Figures and charts must be displayed clearly and not blurry. They must be centered and “in line with text”. Figure numbering starts from 1 onward and is not linked to chapters or sub-sections. The figure caption is placed directly below the figure. Captions use capitalization at the beginning of each word [1].

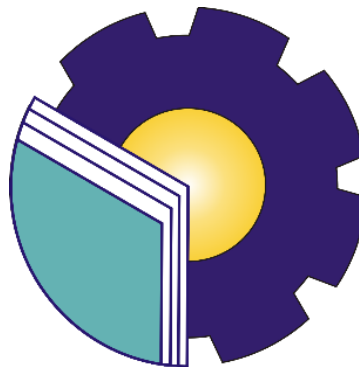


Figure 1. Logo of Bengkalis State Polytechnic Times New Roman 10.

When referring to a figure, do not use “above” (e.g., “in the figure above”); instead, refer directly to the figure number (e.g., “in Figure 1”).

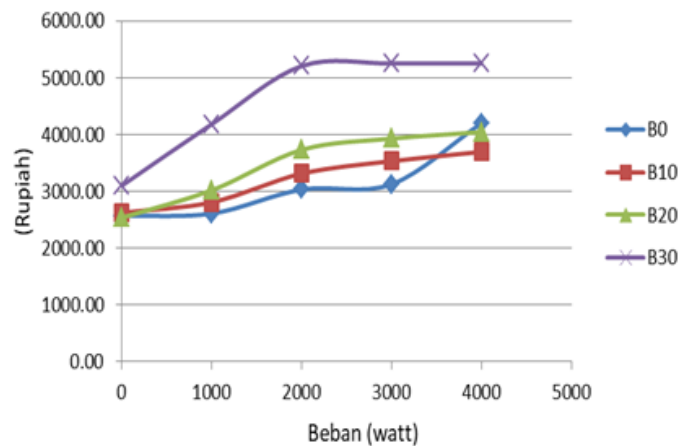


Figure 2. Bengkalis Chart Times New Roman 10.

3.3 Mathematical Equations

Equations should be written using the Equation Editor in Microsoft Word. Mathematical equations are placed in a two-column borderless table. The first column is used for the equation and should be centered [7].

The second column is used for the equation number. Equation numbering starts from 1 onward and is not linked to chapters or sub-sections. Numbers are in parentheses (e.g., (1)) and aligned right.

Symbols used in equations must be explained in paragraph form; listing them downward is not allowed.
