This is a Quasi-judicial hearing and members of the public are invited to attend and observe the hearings, but will not be able to participate.

At the close of the hearings, the Board will enter deliberations and a written decision of each case will be issued within 30 days.

If an applicant (or representative of the applicant) fails to appear at the hearing, the abatement request will be decided based on the information submitted in the abatement request form.

Applicants are asked to provide a minimum of your 2024- and 2025-Income Tax Returns including the HS-122 and HI-144. Copies of applicants' 2024 and 2025 Property Tax Bills will be provided at the hearing.
