

GIRLS AND BOYS VOLLEYBALL

11.0 GOVERNING RULES

The National Federation rules shall govern all play except where modified by CIF or the Sac-Joaquin Section.

11.1 CONTACTS

The Sac-Joaquin Section (Bylaw 505.C) will determine the number of maximum allowable contests (28). Scrimmages for all levels are limited to two per team.

11.2 START DATE

Start and end dates will be determined by the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section

11.3 PLAYER CLASSIFICATION

Refer to CIF SJS bylaw 503.5

11.4 RULES OF THE SPORT

- A. The home team must report the final results to MaxPreps
- B. The facility should be ready for warm-ups thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the match. There will be a maximum of 19 minutes for warm-up.
- C. League game days will be determined by the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section.
- D. All game balls must bear the National Federation authentication mark.
- E. There shall be two officials for both the JV and Varsity game and one official for the Freshman match. If one official fails to show, the coaches must agree to:
 - 1) Play with one official
 - 2) Use a player, teacher, or other person to be the second official.

11.5 ALL LEAGUE AWARDS AND SELECTION PROCESS

Varsity coaches will meet at the end of the league season to select the Coach of the Year and the All League team of 14 players, which includes the Player of the Year.

- A. Nominees for Player(s) of the Year will be taken.
 - a. Coach's vote on Player of the Year
 - i. Winner is given an "At Large" All League position
- B. Each coach, in order of league finish, will announce his/her All League players according to the following:
- C. Schools shall be awarded positions on the All League team according to their finish in League Competition. Each school shall make their own determination as to who will be placed on the team from their school. When there is a tie(s), if there is an extra All League slot, playoff tiebreakers shall be applied in order. The team who earns the higher slot will be awarded the extra slot.

D. Each coach, in order of league finish, will announce his/her All League players according to the following:

- a. 1st Place = 4 players
- b. 2nd Place = 3 players
- c. 3rd Place = 2 players
- d. 4th Place = 1 player
- e. 5th Place = 1 player
- f. 6th Place = 1 player
- g. +2 at large selections

E. Coach of the Year Process:

- Nominations will be taken.
- A Coach can not nominate himself/herself.
- Coach's vote on the winner. A coach cannot vote for himself/herself

11.6 POST-SEASON QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE

A. The number of playoff qualifiers will be determined by the Sac-Joaquin Section.

11.7 TIBBREAKING PROCEDURE

In case of a tie for league representation in post-season playoffs, seeding/qualification will be determined by:

1. Head to head competition during the league schedule
2. Total games won in head to head competition
3. Point differential in head to head competition
4. Total games won in league play
5. Coin toss

11.8 TIBBREAKING PROCEDURE

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
