

Privacy Policy

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Welcome to OKhuman. This Privacy Policy explains how Authentikeyed AI, Inc. collects, uses, discloses, and retains your personal information and usage data when you use the OKhuman mobile or desktop applications and the OKhuman website. It also explains why we collect it and how you can control your information. We are committed to minimizing the data collected from you, protecting your data, using your data only for the purposes you expect, and ensuring transparent privacy practices. About The OKhuman Application and Online Services

The OKhuman software application runs in the background while a user creates a text document in their preferred writing applications. The software and online services together generate an “OKhuman Stamp,” which includes data about your writing session and proves the human effort in creating written content.

OKhuman also showcases your Stamp on the OKhuman Website. On the Website, you may add User Content to update your name, profile picture, and description of your work, and link to third-party sites in order to share your portfolio of stamped works. You may share your OKhuman Stamp by sharing the Stamp URL along with your work. You may also use the OKhuman LTI integration to share stamped submissions with your online learning management system in use by your educational institution. In both cases, you control how your OKhuman Stamp is shared.

When you type, we collect only the minimal data necessary to create the OKhuman Stamp. When typing with OKhuman, your text never leaves your device. Rather, we prove your effort in a document using a cryptographic representation of your text. That representation cannot be reversed back into your text, by us or anyone else.

We also collect data from your keyboard and mouse while you type, and use that data to document your writing effort and generate your OKhuman Stamp.

The Stamp data and metrics reflecting the use and performance of the OKhuman software may be shared with OKhuman’s online services, Website, and LTI Integration, along with any comments, links, or feedback you provide for the Website. When using an LTI Integration, your full text or text file will also be temporarily shared with our online services, then discarded after



the cryptographic process is complete. You have the ability to access or delete your data, or withdraw your consent at any time.

Privacy Practices

This section describes the information we collect, why, and what control you have over it.

Data We Collect

When registering for the OKhuman software and services, we collect the following types of information.

Information you provide to us. This includes registration details (name, email, password) and any comments, feedback, and support information. This also includes information you may add to your profile on the Website including User Content.

Limited information collected from your device and accessories while you type. The OKhuman software collects keystroke patterns, mouse movement data and typing behavior metadata; and, from your mobile devices, screen-taps and gestures. The characters that make up your text never leave your device. Only cryptographic hashes of the text, not the text body, are transmitted to the OKhuman online services. When you Stamp your work, the first 6 words or the first 50 characters of the text (whichever is shorter) is also transmitted to OKhuman and retained solely in order to let the user identify the work.

Data necessary for and related to the operation of the software This includes device type, operating system, and usage statistics of the software and writing applications you permit, as well as the IP address of your device.

OKhuman is not intended for users under thirteen (13) years of age. We do not knowingly collect information from individuals younger than 13, and will promptly delete such data if we discover or are notified that we have inadvertently collected it.

Device Permissions

OKhuman requires the following device permissions to verify that a human is typing the text.

Accessibility. To track your text across writing applications and observe your keystrokes, and mouse movement on Windows and macOS computers, OKhuman requests awareness of which application is currently running, text elements and whether they are editable, your keystrokes, and your mouse movement data.



Enable keyboard app. On mobile devices, you must permit OKhuman to be an allowed virtual keyboard, which is then used to observe your keystrokes and gestures on the keyboard while you type. Further, full access is required by the OKhuman keyboard app. This allows it to connect to OKhuman online services to stamp your typing and generate the one-way cryptographic hashes of your typed text.

Why We Use It

We use collected data for various purposes, including to provide the services you expect and to operate our business. Primarily, data is collected by the software and transmitted to our online services to generate and present your OKhuman Stamp. Through the generation of an OKhuman Stamp, we document human involvement in the creation of written content. We do not identify the individual who typed the text, though the Stamp is associated with your OKhuman account.

The data collected on your device is processed on your device and by our online service to document human writing effort in creating text. The transmitted data cannot be reversed to reveal your text.

OKhuman does not record or store the text content you create except, as outlined above, the first 6 words or the first 50 characters of the text (whichever is shorter) for a document title used for you to identify the document.

The operational data are also collected and stored to improve and secure the OKhuman software and services. The data will also be used to communicate with you by, for instance, providing user support and to fulfill other legal obligations.

The Stamp and associated data is used to populate the OKhuman Website. User Content is also collected and stored in order to share with others, as you select, on the OKhuman Website.

We do not sell data or share user data for any purpose, including behavioral or targeted advertising.

Legal Grounds

By agreeing to Terms of Service incorporating this Privacy Policy, you provide your consent for OKhuman to access keyboard and mouse interfaces on your device(s). OKhuman has a legitimate business interest in collecting this data, for instance to improve our software and services and ensure their security. OKhuman is also required to collect certain data to comply with legal obligations.



Data Retention and Sharing

We retain data only as long as needed to operate the service or as required by law, and not longer than twelve (12) months after you terminate your account with us.

We do not sell or share your personal data for monetary gain. We may share data with affiliated service providers under strict contractual confidentiality and data protection terms, where you provide your consent to it being shared, or with legal or regulatory authorities when required by law.

Security

We implement appropriate organizational and technical safeguards, including encryption, secure authentication, and data access controls. No transmission or storage system is fully secure, and users assume risk when transmitting data. OKhuman disclaims any liability for data breaches to the maximum extent permitted by law.

Your Rights

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may request access to your saved data or terminate your account to delete your data at any time. You may also have the right to correct certain inaccuracies in your personal information. You may also withdraw your consent for the data sharing required to use the OKhuman at any time, though this will result in termination of your account and discontinuation of your access to the OKhuman software and services.

California Privacy Rights

Pursuant to the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), California residents have the right to:

- Limit the use of sensitive personal information (we do not collect such data as defined by CPRA)
