FORMAT & FAQ'S

The Star Wars: Legion tournament is a Grand Tournament and will use all rules and regulations outlined in the GT packet and Galactic Conquest Rules. The following will be used for our events except where otherwise noted:

- Armies should be painted to a three-color standard. Models are not required to be based. The easiest way to ensure you meet this requirement is a base coat on each model, a wash, and color on the mini's base. Please email us if you need clarification on whether you meet the Standard. Players who fail to meet this requirement will be given a Hard Warning.

- Players should have all the materials needed to play Legion. This includes tokens, models, silhouettes, and associated unit/upgrade cards. Players must have at least one copy of each unit and upgrade card in their list but must be able to denote the status of exhaust and expend cards or abilities to their opponent. Players who fail to meet this requirement may be disqualified.
- Players must sign up for the event and submit their lists on [Longshanks](#) using the JSON format by Monday, September 28th (Midnight PST). Failure to do so will result in a Hard Warning.
- Miniatures must follow Atomic Mass Games' current Star Wars: Legion Galactic Conquest document rules. Please contact us if you have mini-legality questions!
- We are using [Longshanks](#) for the event. Once you have registered for any of the Legion events, please go to the event page and “Sign up”. We will double-check your entry against ticketing and then approve you once it’s been verified. This will allow you to submit your list on time.

Format

- Infinities is played using the 600 point [Recon format](#), with different listbuilding rules that are listed below. Battleforces are not allowed in this format.

Commander/Operative: Each army must include 1-2 Commander and Operative units. At least 1 unit must be a Commander unit.

Corps: Each army must include 2-4 Corps units.

Special Forces: Each army may include up to 2 Special Forces units.

Support: Each army may include up to 2 Support units.

Heavy: Each army may include up to 1 Heavy unit.

- Out-of-faction units are not a part of your chosen faction when building a list. Out-of-faction units are considered friendly and are considered part of that army’s faction during the game. Mercenary Units are considered to be Out-of-faction if you could not normally take them in your faction. Keywords that reference a faction or affiliation, are considered to be of your army’s faction.

- Out-of-faction units do not count toward the minimum number of ranks required in an army, but they do count toward the maximum ranks allowed. An army may include up to 2 Out-of-faction units of the ▲ rank and up to 1 Out-of-faction unit of each other rank.
- Players must follow tournament rules as stated in the [Star Wars™: Legion Core Rulebook](#), [Star Wars™: Legion Recon Rulebook](#), and the [Star Wars™: Legion Galactic Conquest Document](#).
- If a game has not concluded when the time for a round is called, the Head Consular will start a new round timer for 15 minutes. If the 15-minute time expires before this game has concluded by the end of game procedures, it immediately ends and the players calculate their scores.
- This event will allow the use of all *Star Wars: Legion* expansions available and fully released by 9/28. Likewise, it will use the current *Star Wars: Legion* Core Rulebook, FAQ, clarification, and errata, which can be found on the [AMG Forums](#).
