The verses listed below correlate to the lessons your child will learn this spring. Learn and discuss them as a family – practice at breakfast, in the car, at dinner, at bedtime. Children should be prepared to recite each verse to leaders (with minimal help) on the date listed. **Those who recite all the verses will earn a trip to Ninja Golf in early May!**

### **Spring 2026 Verse Schedule**

January 18th – Jonah, Prophet to Nineveh; *Unit 14, Session 2 (Jonah)*

- **Jonah 3:10** God saw their actions —that they had turned from their evil ways—so God relented from the disaster he had threatened them with. And he did not do it.

January 25th – Hosea, Prophet to Israel; *Unit 14, Session 3 (Hosea)*

- **Deuteronomy 13:4** You must follow the Lord your God and fear him. You must keep his commands and listen to him; you must worship him and remain faithful to him.

February 1st – The Northern Kingdom Was Destroyed; *Unit 14, Session 4 (2Kings 17)*

- **2 Kings 17:7** This disaster happened because the people of Israel sinned against the Lord their God who had brought them out of the land of Egypt...and because they worshiped other gods.

February 8th – Judah's Good Kings; *Unit 15, Session 1 (1 Kings 15; 2 Chronicles 14-15, 22-24)*

- **Psalms 145:9** The Lord is good to everyone; his compassion rests on all he has made.

February 15th – Judah Was Taken Captive *Unit 15, Session 4 (2 Chronicles 36)*

- **Jeremiah 11:11** Therefore, this is what the LORD says: I am about to bring on them disaster that they cannot escape. They will cry out to me, but I will not hear them.

February 22nd – Ezekiel Gave Hope; *Unit 15, Session 5 (Ezekiel 37)*

- **Ezekiel 11:19** I will give them integrity of heart and put a new spirit within them; I will remove their heart of stone from their bodies and give them a heart of flesh,

March 1st – **Upward Sunday/Family Sunday, Kindergarten-Fifth Grade in the Worship Service**

March 8th – Daniel Obeyed God; *Unit 16, Session 1 (Daniel 1)*

- **I Corinthians 10:31** So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God.

March 15th – Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; *Unit 16, Session 2 (Daniel 3)*

- **Daniel 3:25** He exclaimed, “Look! I see four men, not tied, walking around in the fire unharmed; and the fourth looks like a son of the gods.”

March 22nd – Daniel in the Lions’ Den; *Unit 16, Session 3 (Daniel 6)*

- **Daniel 6:27** He rescues and delivers; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth, for he has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.

March 29th – Rebuilding the Temple; *Unit 17, Session 2 (Ezra 4-6; Haggai -2)*

April 12th – Esther Saved Her People; *Unit 17, Session 4 (Esther)*

- **Isaiah 25:9** Look, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he has saved us. This is the Lord; we have waited for him. Let’s rejoice and be glad in his salvation.”

April 19th – The Walls Rebuilt; *Unit 18, Session 1 (Nehemiah 1-6)*

- **Nehemiah 6:15a, 16b** The wall was completed... all the surrounding nations were intimidated and lost their confidence, for they realized that this task had been accomplished by our God.

April 26th – The Old Testament Points to Jesus; *Unit 18, Session 5 (Luke 1, John 1)*

- **John 20:31** But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
