Other Useful Tech Tools

- 1. Plickers: My absolute favorite of all low-tech tools. A future blog entry will focus specifically on this so stay tuned!
- 2. Edulastic: Common Core online assessment that takes minimal grading? Yes please! This program is great, free, and integrates well with Google Classroom.
- 3. Padlet: This is sort of an online notepad that students can work to collaborate one something. They log in with their Google credentials then can respond to prompts posted.
- 4. Flipgrid: Video response to prompts and students can also respond to one another's flipgrids. They are limited to 90 seconds in length and can add filters and a snap at the end of the video.
- 5. Nearpod: Interactive teacher controlled presentation system. Students can respond to questions, collaborate with each other, and view the live presentation
