Math Bingo Choices:

Play War: Draw 2 cards, add. The larger sum wins.

Make/draw these numbers using tens and ones:
12, 21, 25, 54, 39, 63, 91

Roll 2 dice to make the greatest number. Ex. 26 or 62. Roll 10 times and record on a paper.
