Dear CMS families,

3rd Trimester Report Cards: Third trimester report cards will be mailed home during the week of June 6th along with NWEA family reports, special education progress reports, and PEAK advanced learning plans.

Transportation Next year: In order to enhance accountability, student safety, and communication, our Transportation Department is rolling out a new system for the 2026-27 school year that will require all bus riders to carry a bus pass ID card and scan on and off the bus. Parents will be able to download an app to view the location of their child and the bus. If your child is planning to ride the bus in 2026-27, you will be required to submit a form to request Transportation for your child before school starts. Transportation will be provided from home to school and school to home, based on our existing routes and home addresses in Infinite Campus. Bus passes will be distributed by schools in August.
