PRESCHOOL

- What foundational truth did we learn today? Jesus Came to Save Sinners!
- 2. What did God put in the sky the night Jesus was born? A star!
- 3. Who can tell others that Jesus Came to Save Sinners? We can!

ELEMENTARY

Matthew 2:10-11, 13-14

- 1. When did the wise men travel so far to see Jesus?
- 2. How was God a refuge for Jesus in the passage of flight to Egypt?
- 3. How is God a refuge for His children today?
- 4. How can you practice trusting God this week?

FAMILY - Read Matthew 2:11 and Psalm 86:9 together.

- 1. What did they do when they found Jesus as a child in a house?
- 2. How did they worship Jesus?
- 3. Who does this verse say will come and worship before the Lord?
- 4. When God promises that all nations will worship Jesus, does that mean people who live in America will worship Jesus? What about people who live in Kenya? What about India? What about China? Mexico? Iceland?

MOMENTS

Proclaiming the truth as you go

- Family Worship: Create a family worship night! For kiddos who can play instruments, try to learn a hymn. Spend time singing, dancing and reading from the Bible or the Jesus Storybook Bible. Talk about how only God deserves glory! Only God deserves to be shown, honored and enjoyed as most valuable.
- High/Low: Play High/Low at the dinner table one night. Go around and ask, "What was the best part of your day and what was the worst part?" Using blocks, boxes or pillows build a fort together. Pretend that your fort is a place of safety. Talk about what makes you feel safe.

PRAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY Take

turns praying together.

Praise Talk to God about how He is a refuge.

Thanksgiving Thank God for what He does and gives.

Lament Talk to God about what feels hard, hurtful or wrong.

Confession Tell God the truth about your sin.

Request Ask God to do or give something.
