Where will the event be held?	Please consider how families with limited transportation can access the event. Can you help arrange transportation or carpools?
Will there be translation services?	Please consider whether translation services will be helpful and appropriate, and if you are able to make these services available.
How will you do outreach for the event? How will families find out about the event?	Please consider doing direct outreach and active recruitment with families who might otherwise be left out, including event info in a robo-call, and printing outreach materials in Spanish and/or other languages (note: the district policy is to provide materials for ALL families in English/Spanishi.e. double-sided).
How might this event or activity include or exclude some groups more than others?	Please consider whether this event might be inadvertently excluding or off-putting to some families. Please consider how it would feel to be at this event if you had limited English, limited funds, or a non-traditional family structure. Is there anything you can do to make the event welcoming and inclusive?
Is there anything else that might help make this event accessible and welcoming for all families?	Please ask yourself this question regularly as you plan your event!

Please submit this form to Ms. Agna so that she can be a resource in thinking through some of these questions as you plan. We know that no events or activities will be perfect, and inclusivity is a goal to strive toward.
