Welcome to Pershing County High School. We look forward to hosting your student-athletes, coaches, families, and fans. As members of the NIAA, our goal is to provide a positive, family-friendly environment that showcases the hard work and sportsmanship of all participants. Any updates to this information will be communicated in advance.

Spectator Guidelines

- Positive, respectful behavior is expected. Disruptive conduct, foul language, or derogatory remarks toward players, coaches, or officials will not be tolerated.
- Spectators are not permitted on the field at any time, including after games. Athletes may be met outside the field gates or at the bus area.
- Noise makers are prohibited per NIAA policy (e.g., air horns, thunder sticks).
- Food trucks and other concessions will be located in the lot behind the school (see site map).
- **Tickets:** Purchase in advance at www.niaa.com/tickets. *No cash sales at the gate.*
 - A single ticket grants access to both baseball and softball games.
 - Shared outfield space allows viewing of both fields.
 - **Canopies are allowed on the football field only. However, absolutely NO STAKES are permitted to secure canopies.** Please use weighted anchors instead.
 - Canopies are not allowed between the fields on the fence line- as they could possibly prohibit the view of other spectators.
 - Hand stamps will allow spectators to move between venues throughout the day.

Venue Access & Parking

- **Baseball:**
 - Closest parking: Gravel lot across the street or along the roadway.
- **Softball:**
 - Closest parking: North end of the football field.
 - No parking around the softball field; fence line is reserved for chair seating only.

Gates open 1 hour before the first pitch each day.

Refer to the site map for entrance and parking details.

Team & Bus Information

- **Team Drop-Off & Bus Parking:**
 - All teams will be dropped off and buses parked at the same spot behind the high school.
 - Entry is via the walkway between the weight room and shop for both baseball and softball teams.

- o Buses remain parked behind the school during games.

Locker Rooms

- Available upon request:
 - o **Softball:** Girls PE locker room
 - o **Baseball:** Boys PE locker room
 - o Teams must share and coaches must supervise locker rooms at all times.
 - o Do not leave personal

Batting Cage Access

- Softball cages will be available during assigned time slots only.
- Each Softball team will receive a designated 30-minute window for batting cage access.
- Softball Teams may not use the cages outside of their assigned time.
- Baseball cages will be available before first games of the day, and in between games **only**.

Medical Tent

- A **medical tent staffed with certified EMTs** will be available on-site for the duration of the tournament to assist with any injuries or medical needs.

Game Announcements

- Games will have PA announcers when available, covering:
 - o NIAA sportsmanship messages
 - o National Anthem
 - o Starting lineups
 - o NIAA-sponsored ads
 - o In-game updates (next batter/position changes, when possible)
- Rosters must be updated in AKTIVATE by 10:00 AM on game day.
