

**Oregon Region Pony Club
Junior/Mini Stable Manager Application**

Junior Stable Manager Criteria:

- 9 to 12 years old (at the time of rally).
- A member may be a Junior Stable manager at only one rally. This is designed to be an introductory experience, and after one rally, s/he is expected to move on to participating as a regular team member.
- UR/D-1 certification only.

Mini Manager Criteria:

- 8 years old and under only, or by special permission of the Regional Supervisor.
- A member may be a Mini Manager at multiple rallies, as long as s/he is still 8 years old or under. If the member is capable of participating as a full team member, s/he should be encouraged to do so.
- UR/D-1 certification only.

Requirements:

- If a member has already participated in a rally as a full team member (rider or Stable Manager), s/he is ineligible to be a Junior/Mini Manager.
- Junior/Mini Manager must be a "Member in Good Standing" of USPC and the Oregon Region.
- No more than one Junior or Mini Manager may participate per team, per rally.
- Parent or guardian must be on site at all times when the Junior/Mini is at the rally.
- Junior/Mini does not need to spend the entire rally in the barns. Four consecutive hours per day is recommended as a minimum to gain overall rally experience.
- Junior/Mini must be placed with their own club's team, or majority of team, including Stable Manager. If the Stable Manager is not from the same club as the Junior/Mini, this MUST be approved by the Stable Manager's DC/CA prior to rally entry closing date.
- Junior/Mini must follow all rules as would apply to any competitor, including appropriate footwear and medical armband or bracelet, per Horse Management and Discipline Rulebooks.
- Junior/Mini will wear a special pinny at all times when in the barns.
- Junior/Mini will NOT receive team ribbons for the team placings, but will receive a separate award/gift to commemorate the rally.
- DC/CA must agree that Junior/Mini and the team will be a good fit to facilitate a positive rally experience for all, and will not specifically be an extra help or hindrance to their team.
- DC/CA must agree that Junior/Mini has been involved in club activities and has been prepared adequately for rally expectations and experiences.
