



The below list are items I'd suggest looking at/thinking about for your trip! Of course there are other places to shop besides Amazon, but the majority of these items I personally own and purchased... well... for convenience on Amazon

All Inclusive Clients

[Phone tripod](#)- THIS! If you want to take photos as a couple without asking constantly. It has a remote control with it and takes couples pictures perfectly!

[Silicone Wedding Band](#) - If you plan to be adventurous or are nervous about wearing your wedding ring these are perfect and fun (and worth every bit of money if you lose it!) [Guys](#) can get them, too and they'll come in handy for working out, sports or work! (Be sure to select your correct ring size!)

[Fake ring](#)- if you don't like the idea of your real wedding ring, buy a fake one. This brand holds up great in chlorine. (REALLY suggested if you're someone who removes your ring or it's not sized yet).

[Reusable straws](#)- Most resorts are green in the straw department. Pina Coladas and frozen margaritas are no bueno without one! Thank me later and bring these with you. (If re-using in a group just bring a few pumps of dish soap in a plastic baggie).

[Carbon Monoxide Detector](#)- I don't share this to scare you, but it doesn't hurt to be prepared. See this article contribution [here](#).

["The Bug Bite Thing"](#) - THIS IS A LIFESAVER AND GAME CHANGER when it comes to bug bites. I saw it on Shark Tank and bought it the next day. It sucks the saliva from the mosquito that causes the irritation out of the bite (I know it sounds crazy but I swear by this and so do my kids each summer!) If you have kids, buy the 3 pack and thank me later. A must have on a tropical trip as mosquito bites are inevitable. Snag [this](#), too. Just do it.

[Playing Cards for the Pool](#) - These are UNO cards, but they have [playing cards](#), too! I saw these in Cabo and went right to Amazon to buy them. My kids love UNO in the pool.

[Apple Air Tags](#) - Airlines lose bags- especially in Europe travel. They miss connections and come late. If you have no other use for these- don't buy them they're expensive- ask to borrow one from a friend. *This is especially important for European clients.*

[Round Raft](#)- Some resorts have them, but most don't. This is my happy place in the pool and it's such good quality. My favorite raft I've ever bought and perfect for a pool bar. This [one](#) for babies!

[Liquid IV](#)- This or similar if you plan to drink. Mixing drinks sounds fun and they look cute, but hangovers can ruin your vacation so plan ahead. Gatorade isn't something you can find at most resorts.

[Towel Bands](#)- If you get annoyed with your towel moving on you each time you get up, these help keep it in place!

[Snorkel mask](#)- Having your own snorkel isn't a bad thing. Nor is it if you plan to go on any adventures during your trip off property, or think more vacations are in your future. My set came in SO handy in Aruba because we didn't have to book a snorkel tour, we just went on our own!

[This is the one](#) I have for my kids I bought for our Disney Cruise! If you're fine using the sanitized ones from an all inclusive resort don't buy the adult ones- waste of money, but if your resort doesn't offer snorkeling included you'll be glad you have them vs paying to rent!

[Packing cubes](#)- These are a game changer for packing!

[Space Saver Bags](#) - If you have to pack in a carry and you know you have too much stuff you'll want these bags!

[Scuba Wetsuit](#) - If going to a Sandals resort and planning to scuba more than a couple times I'd suggest buying a wetsuit. Rather than rent it at \$10 per person per day, buy your own to use long term.

[Portable Phone Charger](#)- You only need these if you'll be doing a bunch of long excursions or you'll be using your phone as entertainment on travel day. If not you should be fine.

[Head rest](#)- Overnight flights will never be the same with these. I promise. I slept most of the way home from Hawaii with this. You'll look like an idiot blowing it up on the flight, but you'll thank me when you land! (Hawaii/Europe travelers mainly)

[Foot pillows](#)- Similar for a long flight this will let you curl up. If you have kids sleeping on the flight it'll keep them securely on their seat, too! (Hawaii/Europe travelers mainly)

[Tinted SPF lip balm](#): The sun is bright and your lips can easily get burnt! I love Sun Bum lip balm. Raisin Hell is my go to color, but of course just [regular](#) if you don't want color!

[Coral Safe Sunscreen](#)- Hawaii travelers this is a must. Yes it's more expensive, but the natives of Hawaii will appreciate it. If you aren't going in coral populated water you don't need this.

[Insulated Cups](#)- If you have a cup great, if not buy one! Etsy shops make some cute ones but they're pretty expensive. Resort cups are small and drinks melt fast in the sun. Especially for water it's nice to have one that will keep your dinks cold! (I don't have this personal cup, but have similar ones I've found at Rural King and boutiques online!)

[Wine Bottle Packing Protectors](#)- If you'll be purchasing wine/alcohol or bringing it with you I bought these for a trip and can't wait to use them! (Especially Italy clients!)

[Inflatable beach chairs](#)- Some resorts don't include beach chairs -primarily hawaii and some resorts that are off the beach. Consider trying these to avoid hefty daily rental fees.

[FAN!!!!](#)- I have some clients who go to resorts without Air conditioning (Jade Mountain, Ladera etc.) Having 1 or two of these will be a game changer for your experience. Yes it takes up room, but you'll thank me when you return. I promise.

[Kid activity kit](#)- if you've got toddlers and are worried about the flight, this and similar activities will keep them engaged with the experience, but silently busy! (There are quite a few versions usually one is on sale so find that one!)

EUROPE Clients

[Europe Converter](#) - Europe Clients only

[Portable Phone Charger](#)- You only need these if you'll be doing a bunch of long excursions or you'll be using your phone as entertainment on travel day. If not you should be fine.

[Lightweight duffel](#) - Two reasons you need this. If you plan to shop you'll bring back more than you came with. If you have a hopper flight between countries baggage rules are different weights than typical (Make sure you've looked at them). A lightweight foldable bag like this will be your insurance policy should you need to simply buy a new checked bag- it will be cheaper than paying for extra weight. If you're looking for a sturdier bag to use long term look at the [Foldie](#)!

[Noise cancelling eye mask](#)- A rechargeable Bluetooth inside you can fully block out light and noise by turning on white noise from your phone.

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[Packing cubes](#)- These are a game changer for packing!

[Space Saver Bags](#) - If you have to pack in a carry on only you'll want these bags!

[Apple Air Tags](#) - A year ago I would have told you- you were crazy for thinking this is something you should have traveling. Fast forward to the number of clients having bags lost or severely lost by airlines and I 100% think you should. If you have no other use for these- don't buy them they're expensive- ask to borrow one from a friend. This is especially important for Europe clients.

[Phone tripod](#)- THIS! If you want to take photos as a couple without asking constantly this will be the best \$18 you ever spend. It has a remote control with it and takes couples pictures perfectly!

DISNEY Clients

[Portable Phone Charger](#)- The MOST important thing to bring on a Disney trip is a portable charger. Your phone WILL die during the day so be ready to go.

Here are 3 items I'd suggest that you'll find the most similar to a visit to the Bippity Boppity Boutique!

These [tiaras](#) are just like the ones they would style along with these [bun shapers](#). Spray the heck out of the high bun and top with [pixie dust](#)! The white one is identical to Disney's! I've suggested to other girl moms to buy a new dress from online OR to let them pick out one inside of the parks (They are about \$20-\$40 more expensive than you'd get online but of course nicer quality and probably a little cooler to pick out in person). Look at Target/Costco etc for halloween outfits to save money. If you'd rather have a more multi-purpose outfit try one of these. We bought [this one](#) to be Glenda the good witch and it was a huge hit. Will it be the same as the boutique ... no, but I think if the day before the parks you painted their nails, the morning of did their hair and put some eye make up on then took them to get a dress they'd have a very similar experience and would ultimately feel the same walking around the park. I know my daughter just loved how everyone reacted to her "Mom they think I'm a princess!")

[Noise Canceling Headphones](#) - **If you have little kids who are sensitive to sound I can't suggest getting these enough. The fireworks are extremely loud so having headphones will absolutely help.**

[Kid activity kit](#)- if you've got toddlers and are worried about the flight, this and similar activities will keep them engaged with the experience, but silently busy! Can also be kept in the bottom of the stroller for long lines.

[Glow wands](#)- These are \$30-\$50 in the parks. If your kids are younger and won't care, we have these and they are great quality!

[Stroller fan](#) - If going during the summer especially with a little tyke. Be sure to bring extra batteries

Insulated cups- If you have a cup great, if not buy one! Etsy shops make some cute ones but they're pretty expensive. The cups of water Disney gives you are small paper ones. Especially for water it's nice to have one that will keep your dinks cold!

[Reusable straws](#)- Disney has paper straws. They're awful. Thank me later and bring these with you. (avoid metal ones due to kids drinking/walking and chipping teeth- is it just me that's scared of this?)

[Rain Jackets for kids](#)- These can be hard to find in store. My kids do terrible in ponchos so rain jackets have been the way to go for us. Keep in mind you want a light weight one since it will most likely be hot outside. If you don't have croc type shoes for them invest in them now- target has cheaper knock off ones.

[Packing cubes](#)- These are a game changer for packing!

[Outlet splitter/night light](#) - Too many things to charge and not enough space, plus a nightlight.

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
