#### **NARRATIVE REPORT**

#### **ORGulyo '21: Accreditation of Student Clubs and Organizations**

October - December 2021

ORGulyo is a month-long annual activity spearheaded by the Supreme Student Government to kickstart the Academic Year. It is the conduct of accreditation and re-accreditation of student clubs and organizations of the institutions. Through the passed Resolution No. 1 s. of 2021 – 2022, the formal appellation of the annual accreditation is now known as ORGulyo starting this academic year and every year thereafter.


To prepare for the first event held by the SSG, a meeting was conducted last October 23 presided by the SSG President discussing the timeline of activities for October until December as well task assignment for SG officers. Another meeting was then held on October 25 gathering the aspiring advisers and moderators as well student representatives of organizations to prepare for the annual conduct of accreditation. A memorandum was released by the office of the Supreme Student Government containing the agenda of the organizational meeting which included: Accreditation Application Requirements, Phases of Implementation and Operating Guidelines, Timetable of Activities, and other relevant organizational matters. The meeting held endured for 1hr and 25 minutes with 56 attendees. All documents relative to the conduct of ORGulyo was at this point released to the available platforms.

From October 25 until November 2, the Committee on Assessment for ORGulyo started accepting accreditation requirements from applying organizations. 33 organizations were approved by the committee to proceed to the Phase 2 of accreditation.

## ORGulyo '21: Launching (November 8 – 3PM)

Phase 2 accreditation is main event launching of ORGulyo '21, November 8. The live launching that was supposed to be at 10 in the morning was moved to 3 in the afternoon. The activity was hosted by Jai De Los Santos (SSG PIRO) and Reign Salvamante (SSG Publicity Officer). The program started with preliminaries of Lupang Hinirang and Prayer which was then followed by the Opening Remarks by Francine Majella Papa (SSG President). After the short introductory, the program proceeded to presentation of the student clubs and organizations starting from Academic Organizations. There were 10 Academic Organizations from the 7 Departments in CamHi. After which, this was followed by the presentation of the 15 Non-Academic Organizations. The one-hour launching program ended past 4 in the afternoon. Afterwards, all the promotional materials of applying organizations were published in the page including the registration forms for students to join. Along with the launching of ORGulyo started the recruitment of members which was held from November 8 to 14. On November 15 to 18, the synchronous elections were held. Organizations were only given 4 days to conduct a virtual election as well a general orientation for recruited members and elected officers.

As part of the promotional efforts of the council to engage students in the conduct of ORGulyo, set of online productions was published in the page such as the Nata ta ORGulyo. This included a podcast joined by SSG Officers Giovan, Thea, Naomi, and Majella which aimed to enlighten students regarding the student clubs and organizations of the institution as well as share the experiences of the student-speakers of their stay in previous organizations. And an alumni version of which the council invited known alumni student-leaders of the institutions



answering set of organizational related questions that also had given students an idea of joining in various organizations.

Concluding the Phase 2 of accreditation, the one-day submission of accreditation requirements was last November 20 of which only 23 applications were received. Days after the announcement of the received applications, considerations of other applying organizations were granted through submission of appeal letters. The SSG then submitted an endorsement letter to the Office of the Principal of the 28 accredited organizations. An official list of elected officers for each organization was then released by the council.

## General Student Council 1st Regular Session (November 26 - 9AM)

Following the outset of Phase 3 of ORGulyo, the SSG spearheaded the conduct of the General Student Council 1<sup>st</sup> Regular session last November 26 at 9 in the morning. This was participated by the elected Presidents of the organizations; out of the 28 expected Presidents, only 25 attended. The agenda for the 1<sup>st</sup> regular session included the pending concerns regarding the accreditation process such as the requirements, directory, and organizational chart; the rules and guidelines for student clubs and organizations was also tackled during the session; General Action Plan (GAP); Oath taking ceremony; Himalay: a capacity development session for organization officers; and elections for the GSC Executive Board.



#### **ORGulyo '21: Oath Taking Ceremony**

In the culmination of the ORGulyo '21, the oath taking ceremony for elected organization officers was held last December 6 at 2 in the afternoon via Google Meet. The event was participated by the Supreme Student Government Officers, General Student Council Executive Board, Clubs and Organizations elected officers, Association of Advisers and Coordinators elected officers, and students of grade level organizations.

The program started with a preliminary followed by giving of opening remarks by the SSG President. The guest speaker was then introduced, Mx. MJ Atendido a Project Development Officer from Masbate Division. Through her part, she delivered mostly the experiences of her tenure as a student leader until now that she is a government employee of which most attendees related to. There were also parts of which she has given advice and tips for the student leaders on how they should lead their respective organizations as well becoming an effective servant. After her talk, the principal then gave his short message which was followed by the main program of the event, the Oath Taking Ceremony. The principal presided the oath leading the elected officers of various organizations. After which an intermission number prepared by the Marahuyo Productions which captured the audiences and break the thawed session. Following, the awarding of certificates to the accredited student clubs and organizations. Presently, the council accredited 10 Academic Organizations, 15 Non- Academic Organizations, and 3 Grade Level Organizations.

To formally end the program, the interim Vice President, Mark John Raro gave his brief closing remarks addressing the elected officers of both the General Student Council and the Association of Advisers and Coordinators. The event was a success which ended past 4 in the afternoon.


