Module 5 Discussion

Fun with Senses

STEP 1: Respond to ONE of the following prompts in a primary post of at least 150-200 words:

Option 1: Sensory Superhero

Imagine you have the power to manipulate one of your senses, either enhancing it to superhuman levels or experiencing the world without it temporarily. Which sense would you choose, and how would it impact your daily life and interactions with the environment? Describe how your altered perception might influence your emotions, behaviors, and decision-making process. How might this new sensory ability shape your understanding of the world? Make sure you connect this new sense to something you learned in the course this week.

Option 2: Perception Benders

Find a mind-bending perceptual illusion, such as the Müller-Lyer illusion or the rotating snakes illusion, and delve into its mechanics and psychological implications. Share your chosen illusion with the class, explain how it tricks the brain, and discuss the possible reasons behind its effects. Reflect on the significance of perceptual illusions in understanding the limitations and adaptability of our senses. Additionally, speculate on how knowledge of these illusions might influence your everyday experiences and interactions with the world. Make sure you connect what you learn about the illusion to something you learned in the course this week.

Option 3: Sense and Memory

Consider the close relationship between our senses and memory. Recall a vivid personal memory that is strongly linked to a specific sensory experience, such as a distinctive scent, a particular taste, or a familiar sound. Share your memory with the class, describing the sensory aspects that made it so memorable. Reflect on how sensory triggers can evoke powerful emotions and associations in our minds. Find a peer reviewed journal article that relates to this sense and share it with your classmates. Include a link to the article as well as a brief summary of what the article is about.

Step 2: Return to the discussion forum to comment on at least one other post. Engage with your classmates' posts, offering thoughtful feedback, posing questions, and appreciating the diverse perspectives shared.
