# SGOCE-24-25-01 – GCE New Policy Proposal – Graduate Students' Enrollment in Program (Copper-Glenz)

Students are not allowed to be enrolled in 2 different programs at the same time. The School of Education has had 2 exceptions in their certificate program. Because of the unique situation of those programs, we had a number of students in graduate programs who wanted to take courses from those certificate programs and they were not able to do so. We developed a way for those programs to allow those students to complete a certificate and a masters degree at the same time and take courses between both programs.

We made some changes to the curriculum for both of those areas. Students enrolled in a masters program can complete the content areas they need within the masters program; they no longer need to be enrolled in both the masters and a certificate program. We are trying to clean up the records in both of those programs and create a smoother process but realized we didn't have a

formal process in the catalog. The registrar's office recommended that we create a policy in the catalog that simply states that students cannot be enrolled in both a certificate program and a masters program at the same time.

<u>Mark LeBlanc</u> - What does "enrolled" mean? Can they apply and be accepted for the next term or can they not apply until the current credentials are complete?

<u>Becky Copper-Glenz</u> - They can apply but they cannot be enrolled until current credentials are complete.

<u>Mark LeBlanc</u> - Can we add something to that description that will be going into the catalog?

<u>Becky Copper-Glenz</u> - Yes I can add enrolled "registered" to the proposal as a friendly amendment.
