DCS used to help them, is a process that better organizes the tasks and process of decision making; Megan shared e.g. of how DCS used and the helpfulness of the process         Susan communicated with someone familiar with the National CoPT process and talked about our mission and how we are concentrated on fostering local CoPTs. Susan encouraged the team to go back to getting the guide finished and leading by convening. We don't follow the National CoPT model-do we want to explore that?         Jay said that the AzCoPT should find ways to empower locals, and figure out how to identify those folks to work on the local issues. Currently locals aren't leading by convening for the most part, and the groups aren't well known in their communities.</li> </ul> <li>Curtis said the first step in Kaizen is identifying the problem statement.         Megan said she doesn't know what the AzCoPT should look like, or the LCoPTs, and therefore doesn't know how to adhere to the     </li>

National model, and doesn't know how to support the local communities.

Susan said we do have a mission, program statement, and a new PP with that info. Leading by convening means to coalesce around a common issue and change leadership. Getting info into people's hands is a major function. We don't have one on one contact with youth for the most part, as we are statewide leaders, but we can support the local communities. The transition guide is certainly a product of collaboration for our families and youth.

Abel added that as DES employees, we do Az Management System, (some of our team are from DES), but others may not know what it is.

Mellie felt that we need to talk about this, as she feels that we aren't focused and need to do something to focus our efforts. Megan said we never talk about outcomes, and we need to do so. She would vote to refocus around the outcomes we wish to improve, focus meetings on quantifiable goals. I don't think we've had youth or family members since I've joined (I know there's some professional overlap of being a parent and professional). I'd like to see us get more membership from youth and families.
