All plans are reviewed for final approval by our school board. Councils also act in an advisory capacity to school and school district administrations.

Qualifications

Every public school in Utah has a School Community Council. The councils are made up of school employees who are elected by employees and parents/guardians who are elected by parents/guardians of students attending the school. Membership terms are for two years. Elections are held at the beginning of each school year. Parent/Guardian members must have a student attending the school at least one of the two years of their term of service. Employee members must be employed by the school district at the school.
