

Troop 539 Code of Conduct

In order to provide a positive, safe, and enriching environment for all scouts; the following rules have been established:

1. I will follow the Scout Law, Scout Oath, Motto, and Outdoor Code. These are the basis for all the following rules and should be the basis for all of my actions.
2. I am expected to follow the posted or verbal schedule of activities and assignments specified by the troop leadership.
3. I will do my best to be on time and wear the suggested uniform for all troop events.
4. When on outings (such as camping trips, Hi Sierra, etc):
 - a. I will be quiet and in bed by the agreed-upon time.
 - b. Sounds that can be heard outside my tent or cabin after lights out are considered disrespectful and disturbing to others.
5. I will take responsibility for any damage I do to any property owned by a camp, the Troop, or another individual.
6. The use of profanity or abusive language will not be permitted.
7. I will use the buddy system on all troop activities.

Consequences will align with the offense. Egregious issues or destructive behavior will result in a call to the scout's parent to pick up the scout immediately (yes, that applies to events that could be several hours away from Los Gatos).
