**Benteng Pendem**

Benteng Pendem or Pendem Fort, located in Cilacap, Central Java, is a **historic** fortress built by the Dutch colonial government in 1861. The name "Pendem" means "buried" in Javanese, reflecting how parts of the fort were hidden underground. It was constructed to protect the area from enemy attacks and to safeguard the nearby harbor.

The fort has thick walls, narrow corridors, and several underground rooms that were used to store weapons and ammunition. Although some parts of the fort have been damaged over time, many sections remain intact. Visitors can still explore these old structures and imagine what life was like for the soldiers who once guarded the fort.
