February 13 2026	Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation Scholarship The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation is pleased to provide graduating seniors from all Santa Ana Unified School District high schools with the opportunity to apply for seven different scholarships. By applying for these scholarships, you increase your chances of being selected since you are competing locally for the scholarship, and not nationally. If selected, students will be notified in March and will receive the scholarship in April. Make sure to use your PERSONAL GMAIL to access the scholarship; school email blocks the application. Read about the 9 different scholarships below: 1. Alice Garcia Memorial \$1,000 (1 scholarship awarded): a. This scholarship will be awarded to one student who had attended Lincoln Elementary School. Students must have an interest in entering a career in community service. (law-enforcement, fire, education, medical). To qualify, the student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5. 2. Floyd and Phyllis Watson NJROTC \$1,000 (2 scholarships awarded): a. This scholarship will be awarded to one male and one female student who has participated in NJROTC for one or more school years. Students must be enrolled in NJROTC during the senior year. Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0

3. Achieve **\$1,000** (5 scholarships awarded)
 - a. The “Achieve” scholarship will recognize the achievement of graduates with Individual Education Plans who wish to continue to pursue education at a college or university.
4. Nancy Diaz-Miller Memorial **\$1,500** (2 scholarships awarded)
 - a. This scholarship is offered for students who may have had to overcome life challenges and have been actively involved in their school and/or in the local Santa Ana community.
 - b. To qualify, students must have achieved a 2.5 grade point average or higher.
5. Merit **\$1,000** (5 scholarships awarded)
 - a. This scholarship is designed to recognize students demonstrating outstanding academic achievement.
 - b. The student must be actively involved in school activities and community service.
 - c. To qualify, students must have maintained a minimum 4.0 cumulative grade point average.
6. Rob Richardson Civic and Community **\$1,000** (1 scholarship awarded)
 - a. To qualify, students must have achieved a 3.5 grade point average or higher
 - b. The student must have served on ASB for a minimum of 4 semesters
 - c. The student must have participated in Speech and Debate
 - d. The student must have participated in Community/Civic Service
7. SAUSD Retired Administrators **\$1,000**
 - a. This scholarship is awarded to students who have been involved in community service and have demonstrated exemplary leadership skills,
 - b. The student must plan to pursue a career in the field of education.

February 15	Hispanic Scholarship Fund Award: \$500-\$5,000 Must be of Hispanic Heritage, minimum 3.0 GPA (on 4.0 scale). Open to students planning to be enrolled at a four-year university in the 2026-2027 school year. Must submit a FAFSA application. Scholars are selected based on merit.
Every month on the 20th	Innovation In Education Scholarship Award: \$500 Open to any high school senior or college student with a 3.0 GPA. Must complete the online application, letter or recommendation, self-photo, and an essay describing the goal of the particular project and provide supporting documentation (no min or max word/page count). All submissions must be uploaded no later than 11:59 pm PST on the 20th of each month. The submission window closes starting the 21st and will reopen on the 1st at 8:00 a.m. Students are welcome to reapply each month. Previous winners are not eligible to reapply.
February 23	Bill and Meredyth Stern Amigos de Bolsa Chica Scholarship Award: \$5,000 scholarship Application requirements: • High school students on track to graduate by June 2026. • High school transcript or academic record with minimum a 3.0 GPA • Two essays: one detailing personal aspirations and goals, and one describing how this scholarship would help with financial needs for college/university. • Resume summarizing work experience, volunteer experience, awards and extra-curricular activities. • Volunteer experience related to wetland or marine ecosystems may be given priority.
February 23	Frontline Families Scholarship The Frontline Families Scholarship Fund was established by Dr. Michael Osterholm, world-renowned epidemiologist, to provide educational assistance to the surviving

	children of frontline healthcare workers who lost their lives in the fight against COVID-19. All eligible applicants will receive awards ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500, with the total amount depending on the applicant's demonstrated financial need. Eligibility: • A child of a deceased frontline healthcare worker who died from COVID-19 while employed at a medical facility. • High school seniors, high school graduates, or current college undergraduates. • Planning to enroll in full-time or part-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year. Children are defined as biological, step- or legally adopted children age 26 and under as of the application date. Frontline healthcare workers are defined as the following occupations: nurse, physician, diagnosing clinician, health care support, medical first responder, healthcare technologist, community or social worker, administrator/administrative support, security personnel, cleaner, culinary/food service, coroner, and pharmacist.
February 24	McDonald's HACER National Scholarship The HACER scholarship winners are selected based on their academic achievement, community involvement, and financial need. The rigorous selection process includes a completed application, a personal questionnaire and interviews with a distinguished panel of judges representing academia, business, media, and McDonald's.
February 27	STEM Stars Actuarial Scholars Program Through this unique program, they promote access and opportunities for students skilled in math and interested in becoming actuaries. Our STEM Stars receive a \$20,000 scholarship (distributed over four years at \$5,000 annually) as well as mentorship from actuaries, exam resources, immersive in-person and virtual experiences, exposure to internship and industry opportunities, and guidance throughout a student's college experience. To qualify for the STEM Stars Actuarial Scholars Program, applicants must meet the

	following criteria: • Current High School Seniors or College-Bound Students: Open to individuals in their senior year of high school or those who have graduated high school within the last two years and will enter a 4-year university as a freshman. • Academic Performance: Applicants should exhibit strong academic performance, with a minimum overall GPA of 3.0, an SAT Math score of 600+, or an ACT score of 25+. • Math Proficiency: Has a demonstrated proficiency in mathematics, including Algebra, Calculus, state tests (Proficient or Advanced), and/or completion of Advanced Placement classes. • Recommendation: A recommendation provided by a principal, teacher, guidance counselor, or another qualified professional is required. • Actuarial Career Aspirations: Candidates must express a sincere intent to pursue a career in the actuarial field. • Work Eligibility: As part of this scholarship program, recipients may be connected with internships, or other opportunities that require legal employment eligibility in the United States. Applicants must be legally authorized to work in the United States. U.S. Citizenship is not required.
