

Assemblyman Davis runs a fundraiser for the Sierran GOP at a beautiful dining hall in Castle Rock, Colorado. Inviting prominent gun activists and manufacturers, there's an entry fee of \$1,000 a plate. There's a fancy buffet, filled with steak, lobster, fondu, and other elegant foods. Formal attire is expected. Guests are encouraged to bring their guns and demonstrate them to each other in the firing range adjacent to the dining hall. Many come up and give toasts to Phoenix Davis, Panther T. Ride, and Atlas Black. Eventually, Phoenix is called to give a toast and thank the guests. The speech is as follows:

So when we leave this room, I ask you to remember your fellow soldiers and remember what you're fighting for. I couldn't possibly get through all the heroes in this room, but I'd like to address at least one.

Wayne LaPierre, you have done a world's worth of work all across the country. You're constantly fighting for the right to bear arms, whatever it takes. Guiding an organization that will work to recall those who infringe our rights and fighting to elect all those who will fight for them. You and your organization have accomplished untold work for our rights. I'm so glad you were able to appear here today.

Of course, you're all here to discover what we'll do for you. On the docket right now, Black *[Gestures to Atlas Black]* and I are sponsoring numerous bills to liberalize gun ownership. One of which seeks to deregulate rifles, and another of which seeks to repeal Red Flag laws. We have a long way to go in terms of deregulation, but with your help, we can continue to make progress in our fight for liberty. It is my goal to make sure that the only bar on arms is those who have already committed a violent crime. Together, we can make that dream a reality. CHEERS! *[Drinks champagne]* Panther, do you have anything to say?"

[Panther nods to Phoenix then chooses to stand on their chair to give their speech. They clear their throat and begin talking.]

"First of all, I would like to thank you for permitting me to be here to experience this amazing event. I don't have much to say but I hope it's important. I would like to point out that, in my opinion, we have had a great assembly. Very few problems arose. I, of course, believe that the GOP's majority hold on the assembly helped this. I hope that we can accomplish yet another majority this time around. Another thing that I would like to talk about is gun rights. A very fine bill, SB-05-26 was rejected by the governor. This bill would have made Sierra a gun sanctuary. I believe that this is all I have to say. Again thank you for allowing me to talk, Something something opium." *[Panther hops down from their seat, begins sitting in it again.]*

[Phoenix looks unamused by the cat's antics.] Thank you Assemblyman Ride. And thank you all for coming here. May we protect gun rights and gun businesses. Have a good night and enjoy your meal. *[Phoenix spends the rest of the night having one on one interactions with the guests, learning about their unique voter and donor interests, and how to continue to garner their support.]*
