❖ Regular Weekly/Bi-Weekly Assignments

- ➤ All book assignments can be found here: <u>2025-26 Assignment Calendar</u> You will find that assignments are typically due on Mondays, Thursday (for Odd Classes) or Fridays (for Even Classes)
- Students will have Terms/Vocabulary assignments where they are required to write out the definitions: <u>Fall Terms Word Bank</u> <u>Spring Terms Word Bank</u> <u>Sample of Terms</u> <u>Notebook</u> Students then will have a 26 item quiz on these terms.
- > Students are allowed to use their notes on the quizzes and tests, as long as they are handwritten. But, not on the Final.
- ➤ Every Friday students will have an <u>AllSides Worksheet</u> assignment due. This assignment meets the California Standard of Current Events and Media Literacy.
- ➤ In class activities are theme based, for example we just completed the Civil War and Reconstruction. Students will work through "follow-along" and/or independent study worksheets which are also found on the class website: Projects and Activities. A comprehensive final will be administered at the end of each term. The final is a 130 item exam based on the terms your student has been quizzed on throughout the semester.

➤ ALL ASSIGNMENTS, unless otherwise directed, ARE TO BE SUBMITTED HANDWRITTEN. This is unfortunately due to the amount of copy & pasting I witnessed last year.

❖ Make-Up Late Work Retakes

- Make-Up Work: If students miss assignments due to being absent they are allowed to make up assignments for full credit. Missed assignments should be made-up within two days of that singular absence. If your student needs more time due to an extended absence, please have your student work out a plan with me.
- ➤ <u>Late Work:</u> Students are encouraged to complete and submit work even if it is late. That assignment will lose 5 points per each class meeting it is late (classes generally meet 3 times a week).
- Retakes: I highly encourage students to retake quizzes for a higher grade. They must do this within one week, or by other arrangement, from the original quiz date.
- ❖ IT IS REQUESTED THAT STUDENTS USE POND TIME TO DEAL WITH INDIVIDUAL MAKE-UP, RETAKES, ETC. Students WILL NOT be given class time. I am also available before school and after school by appointment.

- Grades: Because there are typically three graded assignments a week -- I try to update Infinite Campus on a regular/weekly basis. Be sure to check often! I recommend checking your students' US History grade on Sundays.
