Stake Presidency Responsibilities

President Horsley

- o Area Presidency
 - Keep stake focused on Area/Prophetic priorities and vision
 - o Area Seventy
 - Quarterly training
 - Train/update the Stake leaders soon after training
 - o Bishops
 - Always be available for communication and counseling
 - Meet for stewardship interviews every other month (4 each month)
 - Bishop Training/Council meetings
 - o Stake Relief Society Presidency
 - Monthly stewardship meeting
 - Unleash the power of the Relief Society in the Stake
 - Meet with Stake and all Ward Relief Society Presidents once each semester
 - o Missionary Efforts in the Stake
 - Missionary coordination meeting 1-2 times/month
 - Coordinate work with Missionaries and the Ogden mission presidency
 - Interview and work with those preparing for Missionary service
 - Devotional in the Fall for all Return Missionaries (<1year since returning)
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President Peterson

- o Stake Council/Stake High council
 - Train new members of the Stake and High Council
 - Schedule for Stake Council Speakers in the Wards
 - Stake council 2X/month, High Council 30 min. before 1X/month
- o Temple and Family History (Include your wife in these efforts)
 - Train New Ward Temple and Family History Leaders
 - Meet each semester w/ all Temple and Family History leaders
 - Organize a Devotional on the Endowment and Family History – Fall

- Work with Bishops/Wards to unleash the power of Temple Covenants
 - o Sunday School
 - Work with Brother and Sister Richards
 - Train Ward Sunday School presidents
 - Teach and model *Teaching in the Savior's Way*
 - Ensure monthly ward teacher council meetings happen
 - Meet/Train once each semester with all teachers in the Stake
 - o Stake Music Council (Include your wife in these efforts)
 - Train and Meet Council members
 - Meet every other month with the Council
 - Create a list of all members and musical talents
 - Devotionals for Christmas and Easter
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President Chang

- o Elder's quorum Presidencies
 - Train New Elder's Quorum Presidents (HC can train counselors)
 - Meet individually with Elder's Quorum Presidents once each semester
 - Together with all EQP and Ward RSP once each semester
 - Unleash the Power of Ministering in the Savior's way
- o Stake Activities Council/Committee (Include your wife in these efforts)
 - Be Creative – Focus: Jesus Christ, Connection, and Joy
 - Lots of Activities – High-quality activities, food, and memories
 - Meet often with your Council/Committee
- o Institute
 - Train and work with Stake and Ward Institute reps
 - Meet once each semester with all the reps
 - Unleash the Power of the Institute in the Stake
 - Personally visit every ward during the second hour at the beginning of the Fall semester for a few minutes to bear testimony and invite to institute
