

[Call for Participants] IPSF Online Jeopardy CSE on Cancer 2022

I. Introduction

The IPSF Online Jeopardy CSE on Cancer 2022 is an online event organized by IPSF Professional Development committee which serves as a way to promote the importance of clinical pharmacy. Pharmacists, among other healthcare professionals, play a tremendous role in cancer management at various stages ranging from diagnosis and treatment options, to symptoms management, and supportive care.

Students join this competitive event in teams of four and go head-to-head answering questions before their opponent, winning points for a correct answer and losing points for an incorrect one. The cases and questions will cover a variety of topics related to oncology with a selection of multiple choice questions and short answer questions and solve a clinical case as the final question.

II. Objectives

- To show that pharmacy involves more than just knowledge and understanding of medications than knowing the name and dose of a drug.
- To encourage students to think of the processes behind the treatment of a patient, to encourage them to ask questions about the therapy, and to increase the confidence to make suggestions and changes contributing to improving the patient outcome.
- Improve pharmacy students' understanding of cancer diagnosis and treatment options.
- Prepare pharmacy students and recent graduates to take an active role in cancer management and patients' care.

IV. Competition Mechanism

1- Registration

Any interested students are eligible to register in a group of 4, via [google form](#), from 13th February 2022 00.00 GMT+0 till Thursday, 24th February 2022 23.59 GMT+0 .

This competition has a limit of 6 teams (24 participants) and it is indeed first come first serve, however we are going to have 2 teams as reserved.

Participants will need a specific code which they can receive through their Contact Persons to register for the competition.

2- Team Announcement

Teams will be announced via email once the registration is finished.

3- Competition

Introductory Workshop:

- An introductory workshop will be held on Saturday, 26 February 15:00 GMT+0. During the workshop, we will go through the whole process and the regulations of the competition and Participants will have the opportunity to ask their questions. Also, we will Have a few easy, unrelated example questions that can help explain how the competition is run.

Competition process:

- All participants should change their names in this pattern: number of team_Name(ex: 1_Shidrokh). It is recommended Each team nominate one speaker.
- There are 6 topics with five questions each, containing 2 multiple choice questions and 3 short answer questions (Each question is allocated a different number of marks. more marks will be awarded to harder questions.)
 - For example, the 'question' might be, "an antibacterial used for malaria prophylaxis?" The students will then answer, "doxycycline?"The questions will be shown in a slideshow, one by one (there is a list of the questions for the host or organizer of the event).
- One topic will be picked to start and the first question will be shown.
- Team members add their team number fast, when they know the answer. and we can see the list of participants who want to answer respectively.
- We give the floor to the first team to answer the question.
 - positive points for the correct answer and negative points for the incorrect one is considered.
 - If they answer correctly, they get to pick the next question and can go head-to-head answering questions before their opponent until they answer incorrectly or can't answer the question in one minute.
 - If they can't answer correctly in the specific time, we again open the floor for other teams.
- This is repeated until all questions will be answered.
- We will have 3 people running the show, one as the game show host and 2 others keeping track of the score. The points are tallied up and announced, during competition.

- We will have a case as the final question, and teams have 15 minutes to submit answers in google form. Each team can bet their points on the question. If they get it wrong then they lose the points invested on the bet. If they are correct, they gain double points. (In this way, all teams have a chance to win until the last round)
 - In the case of a draw, we will have an additional question. The teams that are tied should nominate one person to answer at the front. This question should show who is more correct or closer to the answer.
- **Winner Announcement**
The winners with the highest score will be announced via IPSF social media and email.

V. Prizes

- Participants who attend the whole session and fill the feedback form will receive an Online Certificate of Participation.
- Top team will also be presented with an Online Certificate of Achievement.

VI. Terms and Conditions

- All IPSF members are eligible to participate.
- This competition has a limit of 6 teams (24 participants) and it is indeed first come first serve.
- We are going to have 2 teams as reserved.
- To take part in the competition, one member from each team should register.
- Selection of a wrong IPSF Member Organization will lead to the disqualification from the competition. Participants are advised to check the name of their Member Organization before submitting the form.
- Participants who do not provide the code or who provide an incorrect code will be disqualified in the competition.
- The questions and cases will be in English and Participants must answer only in English.
- In order to receive the Online Certificate of Participation, the participants must attend the whole session and fill in the feedback at the end of the competition.
- All decisions from judges and committees regarding the winners are absolute and cannot be contested.
- The final winners will be required to submit the Confirmation Letter issued by Contact Person or IPSF Individual Membership Coordinator. Failure to provide the Confirmation Letter will lead to disqualification from the competition.
