

Comet & what I've used it for

Hi!

Comet is prettyyy powerful. I was personally a little lost, wondering "What could I do?" when starting to use Comet. So... I've decided to collect some things I've used Comet for here. I hope it helps someone who might feel like they're not using it to its full potential :)

Productivity

- Send multiple agents to do something in one prompt (e.g. "I read somewhere about [TOPIC], but forgot where – can you go search my Slack, Notion, Twitter likes, etc and find it?")
- Got 2 tabs open and want to compare them? Just @ them!
- Chat about your current tab: The assistant is right there on your sidebar! Ask whatever you want to—YouTube video? Financial Times article? Twitter post? Comet can talk about it to you!
- Quick summarization on websites, and pulling data from other sources right in the sidebar to fact check.
- Simple summarization of received emails (or anything for that matter, like Slack messages). Just ask Comet if you have anything important in those places or something specific, like your flight details.
- Transfer info from one place to another: Reading an email? Ask Comet to make it into a Google doc.
- Brainstorming: Ask Comet to fill out feedback forms/other tasks to get you started – it usually has enough context!
- Auto-fill 2FA codes & click verification links that were sent to your email. No more tab switching!

Personal life

- I saw these cool pants in a video but couldn't describe/find them. I Asked Comet in the sidebar (with a screenshot), and it found them.
- Flight planning: I asked Comet to find connecting flights for a certain date with tough pricing and other limits. It browsed sites and found ones that worked for me.

- More trip planning: Hotels, flights, concerts; I accidentally closed a Ticketmaster page – Comet reopened it, and could open a second day of tickets too that I hadn't yet found.

Fun stuff

- Ask Comet to tell you your music taste—it'll use your search history or even check your actual playlists on YouTube, Spotify, Apple Music, etc.
- Ask Comet to tell you about yourself based on different sources (Raindrop, Notion, Slack, Twitter, etc); e.g., analyze music taste from your playlists by it going onto those sites and looking at them!

In the end, I think the most powerful thing is just searching and chatting with the sheer amount of context from your current tab(s), history, and your preferences that are available in memory, past chats, or even the introduce panel! The more you chat, search, and ask, the better it gets, personalizing answers more and more for you. I noticed this when I started using Comet, and especially combining it with memory. If something like Notion or Obsidian is your second brain, Comet is almost like your second body. And AI & agentic browsers will only get better from here on out!
