To maintain student and teacher safety, campus is closed to food deliveries (for everyone). Plan to bring everything with you in the morning.

Parents/visitors who wish to enter campus are asked to schedule an appointment through the registrar.

- Masks must be worn at all times, including the classroom.
- Students' temperature is checked upon entrance.
- Late students must check in <u>with the Registrar</u> to receive an "Admit to Class" slip. The registrar is located in the main lobby of the middle school.
- Students must use hand-sanitizer before entering school and before entering each classroom.
- Students must sanitize any shared classroom materials/supplies after each use.
- Students sanitize their desks before leaving from every class, with the provided supplies.
- Students must remain socially distant at all times.
 - The Senior Lounge is closed.
 - Season 1 Athletics are canceled.
 - ASEP classes are scheduled to begin soon.
 - Field Trips are not allowed.
- No more than 4 students in the restroom at any given time.
- Students may take their backpacks into their classroom for each block to avoid groups at the lockers.
- HS Students have a 20 minute transition period between classes. During the first weeks, teachers will remain in or near their classroom so students can be gradually released to allow for less people in the hallways. (see attached timetable)
- HS Students stay with their last block teacher for Choicetime from 2:30-3:10. There is no outdoor recess.
- Students may wear a face shield <u>as well as a mask</u> but not instead of a mask.
- Lunch (Students' temperature is checked upon entrance to the canteen before lunch. Students <u>must remain in the Canteen until dismissal by an adult</u>):
 - Grade 5 students go directly to the canteen at lunch. Grades 6-8 wait on the bleachers to be sent to the canteen in groups. (12:10 to 12:20)
 - Grade 12 is dismissed by teachers for lunch at 12:25
 - Grade 11 is dismissed by teachers for lunch at 12:30
 - Grade 10 is dismissed by teachers for lunch at 12:35
 - Grade 9 is dismissed by teachers for lunch at 12:40

School Preparations for CoVid 19 Readiness

Dear TCIS Community Members,

Please find a list of some of the adjustments and preparations put in place for the opening of the school on August 3rd.

- 1. Professional deep-cleaning of the school prior to opening (July 28)
- 2. Temperature scans entering the campus at all entry points. This will be repeated several times during the day.
 - The School has purchased Thermal Scanners for the Main Gate.
 - o All individuals using school transportation will have temperature scans before boarding and will wear masks at all times on the bus.
- 3. Masks to worn by everyone at all times
- 4. All adults must check in and check out with the Thai Chana platform
- 5. Cleaning Protocols
 - Alcohol gels are available in all classrooms and around campus
 - Water bottles: Students bring their own and cannot share with other students
 - o After every class, desks and chairs will be sanitized
 - PE lessons: no contact between students. All PE equipment to be sanitized
 - Bed Sheets will be changed daily
 - o Drop-box for returning books and books sit for 72 hours before being reshelved and recirculated.
- 6. Social Distancing Protocols
 - TAs will greet ECE students at the gate during morning drop-off and escort to classes. Please pick up students right after class.
 - Classroom setup maintains the Ministry of Education guidelines
 - Table partitions in canteen
 - No assemblies until further notice
 - o Increased supervision duty by staff
 - Use of the Playground on a rotation with limited numbers.
 - o PK2 to KG students will eat lunch in classrooms
 - Social distancing maintained in hallways
 - Seating has signage
- 7. Campus remains closed to everyone except staff and students
 - No food deliveries
 - No after school activities until further notice

為了迎接8月3日開始的新學年,學校已經做了許多的措施,來防範新冠肺炎。相關的措施如下:

- 1 學校在7月28日,進行專業且深度的清潔消毒工作。
- 2 體溫測量儀設置在校園所有的出入口,上課期間將多次量測體溫。
 - 學校已經在大門口安裝體溫測量儀。
 - 所有搭乘學校車輛的人員,上車前需量測體溫,搭乘期間須全程戴上口罩。
- 3 所有人須隨時戴上口罩。
- 4 所以的成人須掃描 Thai Chana進出校園。
- 5 清潔的規定:
 - 所有的教室和校園周遭設置消毒液。
 - 學生須自備水壺,不可與他人共用。
 - 每節課下課後,課桌椅都必須消毒。
 - 體育課:禁止學生互相接觸。所有的運動設施都須消毒。
 - 每天更換床單。
 - 歸還圖書館的書籍須放置還書箱72小時之後才可以再次出借。

6 社交距離的規定:

- 助教在上學的期間須在校門口接幼稚園的學生下車,並將學生帶至教室上課。請在下課後立刻接學生。
- 依據教育部的指導方針設置教室。
- 餐廳的桌子設置分隔板。
- 暫停集會直到學校另行通知。
- 增加教職員監督的職責。
- 在限制容留人數下, 輪流使用遊樂場。
- PK2到KG的學生須在教室用餐。
- 走廊須保持社交距離。
- 座位須設置標誌牌。
- 7 除了教職員工和學生外,校園不對外開放。
 - 禁止外送食物。
 - 取消課外活動直到學校另行通知。

การเตรียมความพร้อมของโรงเรียนในช่วงสถานการณ์โควิต-19

เรียนทุกท่าน

ทางโรงเรียนนานาชาติไทย-จีน ขอแจ้งให้ทุกท่านทราบเกี่ยวกับการเตรียมความพร้อมก่อนเปิดภาคเรียนในปีการศึกษาใหม่ ในวันที่ 3 สิงหาคม 2563 ดังนี้

- 1. จัดให้มีการฟนยาฆ่าเชื้อไวรัสโควิด-19 ในทุกห้องเรียน และบริเวณต่าง ๆ ในโรงเรียน ในวันที่ 28 กรกฎาคมเพื่อเตรียมความ พร้อมก่อนเปิดเรียน
- 2. จัดเตรียมเครื่องสแกนอุณหภูมิไว้ที่ประตูทางเข้า และจัดให้มีการวัดอุณหภูมินักเรียนในระหว่างวัน
 - จัดให้มีการสแกนอุณหภูมิครูและบุคลากรที่โดยสารรถโรงเรียนก่อนขึ้นรถ และให้สวมหน้ากากอนามัยตลอดเวลาที่อยู่ บนรถบัส
- 3. ทุกท่านจะต้องสวมหน้ากากอนามัยตลอดเวลา เมื่อเข้ามาในบริเวณโรงเรียน
- 4. ผู้ปกครอง ครู บุคลากรและผู้ที่ทำการนัดหมายล่วงหน้ากับทางโรงเรียน จะต้องเช็คฮินและเช็คเอาท์ด้วยแพลตฟอร์มไทยชนะ
- 5. มาตรการการรักษาความสะอาด
 - มีการจัดเตรียมเจลแอลกอฮอล์ในทุกท้องเรียนและบริเวณรอบโรงเรียน
 - ให้นักเรียนนำขวดน้ำมาเองและไม่ควรใช้ร่วมกับนักเรียนคนอื่น
 - ทางโรงเรียนจะทำความสะอาดโต๊ะและเก้าอี้ทุกครั้งหลังคาบเรียนแต่ละคาบ
 - จัดการเรียนวิชาพละศึกษา (PE) ให้ไม่มีการสัมผัสระหว่างนักเรียน และทำความสะอาดอุปกรณ์ต่างๆ อย่างสม่ำเสมอ
 - 🌼 ผ้าปูที่นอนสำหรับเด็กเล็กจะจัดให้มีการทำความสะอาดและเปลี่ยนทุกวัน
 - หนังสือที่นำมาคืนห้องสมุดจะจัดระบบให้มีการทำความสะอาด และวางไว้เป็นเวลา 72 ชั่วโมงก่อนที่จะจัดใส่กลับคืน ในชั้นหนังสือ หรือให้ยืมต่อ
- 6. มาตรการการเว้นระยะห่างระหว่างบุคคล
 - จะมีการจัดให้ครูผู้ช่วย(TA)เพื่อรอรับนักเรียนระดับชั้นอนุบาล ที่ประตูทางเข้าในช่วงเช้าเพื่อพาไปห้องเรียน และขอ ความร่วมมือให้ผู้ปกครองรับนักเรียนกลับทันทีหลังเลิกเรียน
 - การจัดห้องเรียนเป็นไปตามข้อกำหนดของกระทรวงศึกษาธิการ
 - จัดเตรียมที่กั้นระหว่างบุคคลบนโต๊ะอาหารทุกโต๊ะในโรงอาหาร
 - o งดการจัดกิจกรรม assemblies จนกว่าจะมีประกาศเพิ่มเติม
 - จัดเตรียมเจ้าหน้าที่ในการดูแลนักเรียนระหว่างวัน และในช่วงพัก
 - 🔾 จำกัดจำนวนนักเรียนในการใช้สนามเด็กเล่น และจัดให้มีการหมุนเวียนในการเล่น
 - นักเรียน PK2 ถึง KG ทางโรงเรียนจะจัดอาหารกลางวันให้รับประทานในห้องเรียน
 - มีการทำสัญสักษณ์เพื่อเว้นระยะท่างระหว่างบุคคลบริเวณทางเดินตึกเรียน และที่นั่งนอกห้องเรียน
