

Guidance on In-Person Service Providers

As of August 10, 2021 SFUSD requires that all service providers are fully vaccinated or have a negative COVID 19 test administered within 72 hours of the first time entering a school, then at least every week thereafter. Please refer to the **Vaccination FAQs** for more information.

Agencies are required to review the updated <u>SFUSD COVID 19 Health and</u>
<u>Safety Protocols</u> and slide deck: <u>21-22 In-Person Learning COVID-19 Safety</u>
<u>Protocol Training Slides for Non SFUSD Staff</u> before they begin providing in-person services for students, families and/or staff.

Organizations / agencies offering services outside of the regular school day must follow <u>San Francisco Department of Public Health guidelines</u> for Schools, Childcare & Youth programs.

For organizations providing services through MOUs, see bit.ly/MOU-list to confirm they have a current MOU, and that they have submitted certification they are complying with SFUSD's COVID vaccination requirements before providing in-person services.
