Dear Trinity Parents,

We are thrilled to gear up for the 2021/2022 Trinity season and celebration of 40 years of the Trinity Academy of Irish Dance! The Academy has over 500 dancers across 8 locations in Illinois and Wisconsin. While our teachers and Academy staff are working on choreography, scheduling classes, and creating lesson plans that bring the magic into the Trinity classrooms, your Trinity Booster Club (TBC) is working hard to develop and enhance the enrichment programs that make Trinity unique.

The Trinity Booster Club is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization (EIN 36-4181141), developed to focus exclusively on supporting Trinity Academy of Irish Dance and the Trinity families. TBC's dedicated office staff and our volunteer Board of Directors provide ongoing support to our families through a variety of programs and opportunities. These programs have included items such as:

- · **Communication Resources**: TBC website, Trinity Dance Family Facebook page, weekly newsletters, parent mentors and location leadership
- **Costumes:** school dress rentals, used costume sales, costume inspections and dress storage.
- **School-Wide Events**: Winter Weekend (on hold for 2022), Parades, Milwaukee Irish Fest, Madison Spring Celebration, and the Big Jig.
- **Competitions:** Sponsorship of three well-respected feiseanna (Wisconsin Spring Feis, Pat Roche Feis, and Windy City Feis), coordination of Trinity's participation in major competitions including Oireachtas, Nationals, Worlds, and other International competitions (registration, teacher travel and support, hotel blocks, rehearsal space, costumes and dress rehearsals).
- **Ensemble Trips:** Coordinate all aspects of the trips including teacher, chaperone, musician and dancer travel, itinerary, assist with costuming, coordinate with festivals, secure dignitary gifts, Ensemble marketing, and support the teachers planning the trips.
- Fundraising: Facilitation of fundraising programs to support ALL Trinity families.

To provide these resources, all families participating in the activities outlined above are asked to pay dues to support the TBC.

While your Academy tuition covers the cost of the classes that your dancer participates in, the "behind the scenes" work is completed by our TBC office staff.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Is the Trinity Booster Club financially separate from the Trinity Academy?

Yes. The Booster Club supports the mission of the Academy and Trinity families but we are a separate legal entity, with a separate operating budget.

2. Why do we have a Booster Club?

The experiences for our families and dancers that include parent mentors, school-wide events, costumes, Ensemble trips, regional, national and international competitions are what make us Trinity. It takes a broader organization working to provide the "outside the classroom" experience. Additionally, being a non-profit allows us to fundraise to support these activities.
