Spectator Guidelines for GHS Volleyball

Summary -

- Wear Masks
- Sit on the Blue Dots
- Must be on the pass list
- If you have symptoms, stay home

Glenwood Athletic Attendance Procedures (per the Illinois Department of Public Health's All Sports Policy).

- Attendance is limited to a max of 50 spectators (Phase 4).
- Each player will be allowed to put two immediate household family members on a pass list.
- Spectators must be immediate family members of participating athletes. Immediate family members are parents/step-parents/guardians and siblings.
- Only those on the pass list will be allowed to enter.
- We understand that situations will arise where different family members will want to attend different games on different dates. We have included space on our pass gate form to list additional family members.
- If it becomes available, additional immediate family member spots will be added by seniority (i.e. seniors' immediate family additions first, then juniors).
- Spectators are considered anyone not part of the gameday personnel (players, coaches, officials, athletic trainer, scorestable, and administrative staff).
- A pass list form will be distributed to players and parents via their coaches.
 - The pass list will require the family member's name and telephone number.
 - Name and contact information is important for contact tracing purposes.

- When a spectator arrives at the game, they will be required to check in at a kiosk before entering the gym.
 - Upon arrival, spectators will confirm that they do not have any COVID-19 symptoms.
 - Spectators temperatures will be checked. Anyone with temperatures above 100.4 will be asked to leave.
 - Hand sanitizer and wipes will be provided at check-in. The wipes are available to wipe your seat before sitting in the bleachers.
- Spectators will be required to sit on the Blue Dots.
 - Spectators must remain at least 30 feet away from the playing area and game personnel.
 - Spectators should only sit next to immediate family members.
 - Spectators will be required to six feet apart from anyone that is not an immediate family member.
- Spectators must wear masks.
- We ask that spectators only stay for the game in which their child is playing.
- Spectators should refrain from shouting, singing, or chanting.
- Spectators should follow state guidance regarding social distancing.
- No concessions will be available.
- There will be no admission fee for games at home volleyball games.

Away Games

Coaches will share information with parents as soon as possible for away games. To date, we have been informed by most of the schools on our schedule that they are not allowing visiting spectators. We are operating on the assumption that our fans will not be able to attend away events in person. When we hear differently, that information will be shared. We will also share information about any opponents when they offer streaming services.
