

LSU, in cooperation with local and state law enforcement agencies, has instituted new policies to further protect fans attending LSU football games.

As a part of these changes, a new traffic and parking policy is being implemented this Saturday. At 2:30 p.m. on Saturday afternoon, vehicular entry to the campus will be restricted.

As parking patrons of UUMC, we have been granted approval for entry to the UUMC parking lot past the 2:30 p.m. road closures.

The way it will work is this:

1. After 2:30 p.m., all UUMC parking patrons will come down Dalrymple Drive to a checkpoint stationed at the corner of Dalrymple Drive and State Street.
2. Dalrymple Drive will be the only entry way for access to the UUMC parking lot. Traffic on Highland Road, in both directions, will be diverted away for our parking site. ***[An alternative method of turning on East State then left on Carlotta and to our back entrance may also be used.]***
3. In order to continue on Dalrymple Drive to our parking lot, you will need a printed copy of your UUMC parking permit.
4. Officers will check your permit and then allow you to continue to our parking lot.

We suggest that you plan to arrive earlier than usual, as we are confident that the checkpoint is going to create a bottleneck at that intersection.

We are sorry for any inconvenience this might cause. Thank you so much for supporting UUMC through your willingness to park in our lot.
