Zidoo Bookmarks Setting


When a movie is stopped when playing or switched to another movie, bookmarks will record the current playing time. When you play that movie next time, it will pop up a prompt asking whether or not to continue playing the movie from the last playback time.

The latest FW of Z9X modified bookmarks function, it is divided into Dialog prompt and Text prompt. The other models will update this function soon. Pls see the difference between these 2 prompt modes as below.


Note: Bookmark is only suitable for the playback of local video, not support the playback of online video.

1. Two ways to turn on/off bookmark setting

1.1 Quick Settings→Playback→Bookmarks→Display mode→Off, Dialog prompt or Text prompt




1.2 During the playback of the movie, press the "Menu" button on the remote control→Advanced→Resume function, select Off, Dialog prompt or Text prompt.



2. Bookmark Overview

2.1 Dialog Prompt Mode

When playing the movie again after it exists during playback, a prompt box will pop up. You can use the remote control to choose "Start over" or "Continue".




2.2 Text Prompt Mode(Recommended)

When playing the movie again after it has existed during playback, it will automatically continue playing the movie from last ended time, a text prompt will also pop up in the upper right corner of the screen, press left key to start over.




2.3 Turn off bookmark function



3. Customize bookmarks time


3.1 Start bookmarks time

The movie is considered unwatched within the minutes after starting playback. For example, after setting start bookmark time as 3 minutes, there will be no bookmark when the movie is stopped during 0h0' to 0h30m.



3.2 End bookmarks time

The movie is considered as watched within the minutes before the movie ends. For example, a movie is 60 minutes, after setting the end bookmark time as 3 minutes, there will be no bookmark when the movie is stopped during 0h57m- 1h.
