Learning Outcomes

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

1. Demonstrate their understanding of key facts about the Tower of London by completing a true/false quiz.
2. Enhance their listening comprehension skills by answering questions about a video on the Tower of London.
3. Expand their vocabulary related to historical sites by matching words to pictures.
4. Develop their research skills and deepen their understanding of historical events by exploring the mystery of the two princes' disappearance.

Lesson Stages

1. Engaging Warmer: True/False Quiz (5 minutes)
 - **Objective:** Activating prior knowledge of the topic
 - **Activity:** Show slide 3. Put students into small groups and have them answer the 8 questions.
2. Stage 2: Video Comprehension (1) (10 minutes)
 - **Objective:** Deepen students' understanding of Tower of London and prepare them for their excursion.
 - **Activity:** Show slide 4. Run through the questions and check understanding. Play the video and ask the students to answer the questions individually and then compare their answers.
3. Stage 3: Language work (10 minutes)
 - **Objective:** To revise and extend vocabulary relevant to the excursion.

→ **Activity:** Show slides 5 and 6. Ask the students to first match the vocabulary with the pictures on slide 5 and then put the words in the correct spaces on slide 6.

→ Check answers as a class.

4. Stage 4: Video Comprehension (2) (10 minutes)

→ **Objective:** Deepen students' understanding of Tower of London and prepare them for their excursion.

→ **Activity:** Show slides 7 and 8. Check students understand the language in the tasks. Ask students to make predictions about what could go in the gaps.

→ Play the video and check predictions.

→ Feedback as a class.

5. Stage 5: Research (10 minutes)

→ **Objective:** Independently research an aspect of the Tower of London's history.

→ **Activity:** Show slide 9. Put students into groups and tell them to use their phones to independently research what happened to the two princes.

→ Feedback as a class.

→ Set the excursion mission.
