#### **Brief Course Overview**

## **Course Description:**

This course enables students to understand and use the language they have studied in a range of contexts and for a variety of purposes. We encourage, through the study of texts and through social interaction, an awareness and appreciation of the different perspectives of people from other cultures. The course provides students with a basis for further study, work and leisure, and provides the opportunity for enjoyment, creativity and intellectual stimulation through knowledge of an additional language. Assessments consist of exercises to demonstrate understanding of authentic print texts based on a variety of themes (receptive skills) writtens tasks (integrating receptive and productive skills), oral assessments, interactive orals, and individual orals (presentations). Students must maintain a portfolio (carpeta) of written work throughout the course. Both written and oral assessments are required in the target language.
