

Relay Leg 4 - Monmouth to Redbrook

Number collection - please collect your number from a seating area on the opposite side of the road to the Mayhill Pub.

START – Just up the hill past the Mayhill Hotel. Start is on the constricted Offa's Dyke path. - 150m up here, at the end of the handrail.

Go uphill to the tarmac, then join the lane and continue uphill to the woods and a gate on the left by a right hand bend in the road. Go through the gate and continue uphill through the woods. Do not follow OD signed right by a gate but instead continue straight up the path. Soon a forestry track from the right will join, turn right and go down this track. At the far end it narrows and joins Offa's Dyke near a gate by a road. Turn left up the path. through the woods. At some boulders, bear slightly right and continue up the gully/footpath. Go up the steps at the top and pop out on a path at the top. To your right is the Kymin Lookout/Naval Monument. Turn right.

Stay on the track and pass the monument on ITS left. 50m past it, fork right off the gravel track. Continue, going through a small car park and a kissing gate the other side. Go through some fields to a gate near the corner and turn left. Pass some buildings on the right then continue quite away on the gravel track towards Redbrook. The track eventually becomes tarmac and meets a road. Turn right and continue to an old bridge overhead. Turn left immediately BEFORE the bridge. Go along the track which eventually curves left and then joins the main road, opposite a car park. Continue in the same direction towards a phone box and a village store.

We anticipate that the finish will be along the road before the village stores.

Please support the village shop. They offer a good range of locally made cakes as they cater for people walking the Offa's Dyke. Hot drinks, snacks and ice creams are also available.
