

TOP TEN THINGS TO REMEMBER IF YOU ARE A NEW EE STUDENT!

- 1. Read your SSU email! Do NOT ignore emails about advising and registrations!
- 2. Make sure you attend advising before you register for your classes.
- 3. Seek assistance if you need extra help with your PHYS, MATH, CS, or any EE courses. Please check the available tutoring times posted on Department's webpage.
- 4. Join a club! Get on the mailing list of EE club and SWE club! Be involved!
- 5. Make sure you carefully review EE program's roadmap!
- 6. Be on time to your classes! Be prepared when you go to class!
- 7. If you are taking EE112 or EE110, don't forget completing your Academic Status Form.
- 8. Get to know your professors and introduce yourself to them! You will be with them for the next FOUR years!
- 9. When you email your professors, make sure you start your email with a formal greeting. Always include your name in your emails.
