This is a condensed version of an explanation of an infohazard. Do more research on stuff like this if you take things literally or are sensitive to many triggers.

An infohazard is a piece of information that can cause major shifts in your worldview, or is knowledge that can put the reader in "danger" while reading. Before you leave out of fear that you are hearing some crazy conspiracy that puts your life at risk, know that:
