



## Charlotte High School Parking Agreement

I, \_\_\_\_\_, (print student name) by purchasing a Charlotte High School Parking Permit, do hereby agree that the operation of a motor vehicle on Charlotte County Public School property is a privilege. It is under the control of the state of Florida through the Department of Highway, Safety, and Motor Vehicles and all applicable laws and regulations. I further agree to abide by all Charlotte High School rules and regulations and acknowledge that a CHS parking permit may be revoked at any time for breeches of this agreement.

The Charlotte High School Code of Conduct and the following policy, rules and regulations will apply to all permit holders.

- Parking permits are non-refundable. **Sharing or exchanging of permit tags will result in immediate revocation of you permit tag for the remainder of the school year.**
- Picture ID must be presented when requested by school authorities.
- **Search of a vehicle will take place whenever a school official has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons or unauthorized person/persons are contained within the vehicle.**
- Parking permit must be displayed at all times on the lower corner of the driver's side front windows.
- Parking is allowed only in assigned lot during normal school hours.
- **One-day Temporary Passes are issued in A Building (1<sup>st</sup> floor) before the start of school.**
- All occupants must vacate parked vehicles and leave the parking lot immediately upon arrival to school. NO LOITERING IN THE PARKING LOT BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL.
- Students must have administrator approval to enter the parking lot during the school day after the tardy bell has rung and before the dismissal bell.  
**Unauthorized access to lot and parked vehicles will result in referral or suspension.**
- Students are responsible for all violations incurred by their vehicle and should not "lend" their vehicle to another student.
- Your vehicle can be towed, or issued a citation with financial obligations, for failing to follow these rules.
- Parking permits can also be revoked for the following reasons:

- 1) Habitual offenses of the rules listed above
- 3) Leaving school without authorization
- 5) Speed limit on campus is 5 MPH:

- 2) Excessive tardiness and/or absences to school
- 4) Speeding or driving in a reckless manner

### **I UNDERSTAND THESE RULES:**

- Parking permit fee \$50.00 or \$100.00
- Replacement fee for lost or damaged permits \$10.00
- Violations will be ticketed and an obligation will be assessed against your student ID, which will result in Tarpon in a poor standing classification and prevent participation in activities, events, dances, etc.
- I have read and understand the above parking regulations and consequences. I agree to abide by all Charlotte High School rules and regulations. I understand that a student must be clear of all financial obligations to the school before a parking permit will be issued.

## **PARKING OPTION 1**

Student parking in CPAC lot and the back of G Building these spaces will be unnumbered and be on a first come basis. The cost of these spaces will be \$50 for a single space. If you would like a double space for a large vehicle, the cost will be \$100. The Double space will have to be marked as well for the year.

## **PARKING OPTION 2**

Student will have reserved parking in the first two rows adjacent to G Building spaces 1 through 44. These slots are open to all classes and will cost \$100. Parking Option 2 will give students the right to park in a personal space all year. The space should remain empty all day if permitted student is absent.

**\*\*All attendance rules apply for all students in all spaces regardless of permit paid for parking space. Fees will not be refunded for permits revoked due to attendance or tardy issues\*\***

Students will be issued a warning at five unexcused tardies during a quarter (nine weeks) to school. Parking privileges will be revoked after ten unexcused tardies to school per quarter. If Students reach 5 tardies for the second quarter of any semester, and had their parking revoked the previous quarter, it will be revoked for the semester.
