New Business:

- 1. Treasurer's report: Question from Mrs. Pellegrino about if Arts in Education was used for the movie field trips. She will follow up with the grade levels.
- 2. Proposal to fund Laila's memorial plaque: Passed unanimously to purchase the plaque from Pen and Trophy.
- 3. Upcoming Fundraisers:
 - a. Special Person's day June: June 10, 11, & 12 (Father's day).
 - b. Chick Fil A- June 12
 - c. Cider Rose Tea Party- September 20th- www.ciderroseevents.com use the code ROX10 to help give back 10% to the PTG

4. Ongoing Fundraisers:

- a. Plank Road Bottle Return- mention the RRMS PTG when you drop off
- b. Travel with Fantasies and Dreams- book your trip and mention the RRMS PTG. After you travel the PTG will receive a percentage of the agent's commission. We received our first donation last month!
- c. Box tops for Education- get the app, scan your receipts, the PTG earns money; can also link your Walmart account of the information to go in the app automatically.
- d. Benevity- some companies donate when their employees volunteer, others match donations
 - i. some companies that have donated are Walmart and Amazon. Please check with your employer to see if they participate.
- 5. Brainstorming future fundraisers:
 - a. Peak Martial Arts: They have offered to come to school or provide a punch card for students to come to the dojo. Sensei Kraus reported that events at the school are usually more successful.

 - a. 5th grade parent orientation: date TBD but likely later in June; PTG representation would be good to get parents connected to the Facebook page, webpage, and invite them to meetings
 - i. set up a spirit wear sale beforehand so it can be open at the event with a QR code.
 - b. Locker night/Back to school BBQ: Date TBD (September?) but depends on when student schedules are released.
 - Invite vendors to have a vendor walk in front of the school \$20-25 per table and a donation of a raffle item
 - ii. Need to reserve the district grill
 - iii. Seeking donations of rolls (Marsha's friend), chips (someone can call Terrell's), water (Marsha's friend may donate some but would likely need more), hot dogs (request sent to Hoffman's 6/3/25), condiments, napkins, plates.
 - iv. Check with Kona Ice for availability once we have a date to also include a fundraiser
- 7. Jen applied for an Action Teams grant through Thrivent Financial: Awarded \$250 to do a food drive to benefit the pantry at school.
- 8. Principal's updates:
 - a. Students are enjoying their field trips
 - b. There was better participation in State testing this year
 - c. Grade level award ceremonies- some have happened and others are coming up
