

21-22 LAUSD Oversight Overview

LAUSD is an important partner in our work, they hold us accountable by ensuring we are instructionally, financially, and operationally responsible. On an annual basis LAUSD conducts an oversight visit for each school that consists of documentation submission and on-site observations where they walk through classrooms. LAUSD uses the following sections to provide scores for each of our schools:

- 1. Governance
- 2. Student Achievement and Educational Performance
- 3. Organizational Management, Programs, and Operations, Compliance with Clearance
- 4. Fiscal Oversight

Schools receive a rating out of 4. In the 21-22 our schools excelled in the annual oversight visit. Here are our ratings:
