Chevy Chase Country Club:

- Deposit of \$2,000 paid
- Final payment of XXX due 10 days before the event date (this is not inclusive of gratuity)
- Final arrangements and menu choices must be made within 30 days of the event. Any specialty items like audiovisual equipment, specialty wines/champagnes and linens must be finalized at this time.
- Changes must not be made to the Banquet Event Order within 10 days of the event date.
- We must contact the CCCC staff to schedule the final planning meeting which shall take place no less than 60 days prior to the Client's event
- COIs required from every vendor naming Wheeling Park District is additional insured
- Rental Hours from 9AM-1AM in the Grand Ballroom
 - F&B Minimum of \$12,000
 - All Day Rental of \$1,000
 - They negotiated a **discounted full-day rental** for the venue (already reflected in the contract price).
- Client can pay \$250 to provide their own sweets and late-night snacks from an outside vendor. To go boxes must also be provided by the host. The vendor is required to deliver a receipt with the food items confirming purchase and payment by client.
- Cake must be from a third-party commercial bakery. **There will be a \$1.50 cutting fee per person.**
- Room 1s available 2 hours prior to the start time to setup the event.
- Bridal Suites can be reserved beginning at 3PM. It can be reserved for the entire date at \$2,000, that fee will include a light lunch, a charcuterie board and mimosas for 12 people
- **Drones are not allowed on site**
- No signage is allowed to be affixed to walls/ceilings/stairwells, etc.
- Sparkler exit to be approved by staff but would incur a \$100 clean up and extinguishing fee. Cold sparklers are not permitted
- Candles on the floor/aisle must be flameless

- Smoking is prohibited (including vaping and e-cigarettes). Smoking is not allowed within 15 feet of the building otherwise there is a \$250 fee

Photography: King & Opal (\$9,000)

Mariah

- -\$1000 discount (\$500 for cool couple, \$500 for Heirloom)
- 50% retainer of \$4,000 due at signing
- Remaining \$4,000 due August 30, 2026
- 10 hours of coverage
- Two shooters
- Deliverables: 700 high-res images within 90 days of the wedding | sneak peek within 2 weeks
- Overtime is \$700 an hour
- 2x vendor meals: Photographers will communicate dietary restrictions/preferences when final catering counts are due.
 - They also require (in the contract) to eat when the couple eats. Catering team needs to be aware of this.
- A planning questionnaire will be available for them to complete 2-4 weeks before the wedding
- Photographer recommends appointing a “wrangler” to help identify important family members for candid/family photos.

Videography: Cling & Peck (\$5,100)

- 2 videographers
 - Lead: Joaquin Nolasco
- 8 hours of coverage
- Edited 3-5 minute wedding video
- All RAW footage via download link
- Drone coverage (weather depending)
- A deposit of 50% was paid at signing
- Final payment of \$2,550 due 14 days prior to the wedding
- Final video to be delivered within 90 days after the wedding
- The contract allows the photographer to use non-identifiable photos from your wedding for marketing and promotional purposes, such as their website, social media, or portfolio. It also states that your guests are considered to have consented to this use, and if a guest later makes a claim against the photographer over those images, you agree to be responsible for handling and defending that claim.

DJ: An Enchanted Evening (\$2,099)

- Retainer of \$599 due at signing
- Final balance of \$1,500 due 14 days before the wedding paid by personal check, cashier's check, cash, or one-time Zelle payment)
- Services: Wedding Reception DJ, On-site Ceremony with remote setup, 6 LED uplights, wireless microphone included

- Company may use images, photos, and video footage from the event for promotional purposes.
- Gratuity is Not included in the package price.
- Notes: DJ package is for the reception at a single location/space with no equipment relocation required. Additional services can be added later, subject to availability.

Hair & Makeup: Bridal Beauty Team (\$1,464)

- Retainer of \$650 due upon signing.
- Remaining balance due August 23, 2026 (14 days before wedding).
- Premiere Bridal Hair & Makeup package includes bridal trial, airbrush makeup, waterproofing, lashes, hairstyling, and bridal touch-up kit.
 - Heirloom discount applied: \$50.
 - Travel fee included: \$20.
 - Automatic 20% gratuity included in quote.
- Services may be increased after booking but cannot be reduced once the contract is signed.
- Bride currently contracted for bridal hair + makeup only. Mom scheduled for trial only. Pending trial results, bride may add wedding-day services for mom and potentially grandmother if grandmother is able to attend the wedding
- Estimated service timing is approximately 40 minutes per service.
- Vendor estimates approximately 4.5 hours of getting-ready time, depending on final service count.
- Trials are scheduled approximately 5–6 months prior to the wedding date and take place at their Chicago studio.
- Trials are limited to 3 hours and vendor recommends bringing no more than one guest.
- Additional fees may apply for individual lashes (\$25/person), clip-in extension placement (\$30/person), and Hollywood Waves styling (\$40 for trial and \$40 on wedding day).
- Early morning fee of \$50 per artist applies for start times before 7:00 AM.
- Client is responsible for parking, valet, hotel accommodations (if required), and any approved reimbursable expenses.
- A 3% processing fee applies to credit card payments; ACH payments avoid the fee.
- Bridal party members must arrive with clean faces and clean, dry hair.
- Vendor may charge a \$100 per artist fee for every 45 minutes of delay caused by late or unprepared clients.
