Please make sure that all of the hygiene products you are brand new and sealed. Nothing that has already been opened can be donated. We are accepting shampoo & conditioner, soaps, feminine products, toothpaste, etc.

**Please make sure to sanitize everything  
before donating!**

For canned food and hygiene supplies please sanitize them and put them in a plastic bag. Please put food and hygiene products in separate packaging.
