Primary Award Criteria:

To be eligible for the Scholarship, you must have completed at least one semester at any Wisconsin University or College with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher and be enrolled in at least 12 credits during the Spring or Fall semester (whichever you are applying for the award). The scholarship committee will also need a copy of your college transcript(s). Additional criteria to obtain the Scholarship award are as follows:

- Participate specifically in wildlife and environmental conservation activities
- Affiliated with Wisconsin Wildlife Federation-District 4 West
- Preference will be given to individuals seeking a degree with a Conservational focus, **but all that** enjoy the outdoors are encouraged to apply
- Community/extracurricular involvement
- Work history
- Leadership activity/experience

Award Restrictions:

- Annual scholarship awarded at the end of a given semester after 3.0 GPA has been acquired/proved. Send 1st semester transcripts to: bonkoski@charter.net
- Renewable but must reapply
- No annual/reapplication limit
- Full-time attendance is required
- Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded per year for \$500.00 each

Additional requirements:

- Must submit at least 2 but not more than 3 letters of recommendation.
- Complete and submit a 500-word essay about why you deserve to receive the scholarship. Indicate your objectives. You may want to include information about your educational, career, and personal goals. Demonstrate your talent by writing about any special interest or special circumstances that you may wish the selection committee to consider. In your essay you may also specifically address financial need, employment, family responsibilities, evidence of leadership, community service, or other requirements. **Only one(1) essay is needed.** Essay format: Use 8 ½" x 11" white paper. 12pt font with 1" margins all around
