Summer camp opportunity for girls

Twin Valley Council is offering a special week of Summer Camp at Camp Cuyuna for Scouts BSA all girl units July 2-8, 2023, for a full week option or July 5-8, 2023, for a 1/2-week option.

We are a patrol cooking camp that allows for patrols to function together closely throughout the week helping increase teamwork, problem solving, communication skills, and leadership skills among your Scouts.

We also offer block scheduling of merit badges and a special troop adventure day on July 4 that will allow your unit to enjoy resources in the area both on camp and off camp.

Cost for the week is \$330 if paid by May 5, 2023, and \$360 after May 5, 2023. For those units with July 4 plans, we are also offering a 1/2-week option from July 5-8, 2023. 1/2-week costs are \$165 if paid by May 5, 2023, and \$185 after May 5, 2023.

Why an all-girls week? An all-girls week will give Scouts a chance to network and form friendships with other all-girl troops from across Minnesota

It's time to start thinking about registration for the 2022-2023 scouting year. Registration is now open.

Scouts will be \$180 and adults will be \$45 this year. Financial assistance is available by filling out a form on the registration page.

New this year, all scouts who register by October 31st will receive a multi-tool. The troop will also receive \$20 per scout to help pay for merit badges and ranks.

Visit TWO of the following locations and do either A or B:

Your school

Your place of worship

A Scouting event or campsite

A public exhibit or attraction (such as a theater, museum, or park)

A. Take notes about the accessibility to people with disabilities. In your notes, give examples of five things that could be done to improve upon the site and five things about the site that make it friendly to people with disabilities. Discuss your observations with your counselor.

B. Take notes while observing features and methods that are used to accommodate people with invisible disabilities. While there, ask staff members to explain any accommodation features that may not be obvious. Note anything you think could be done to better accommodate people who have invisible disabilities. Discuss your observations with your counselor.

Name five professions that provide services to people with disabilities. Pick one that interests you and find out the education, training, and experience required for this profession. Discuss what you learn with your counselor, and tell why this profession interests you.

Troop communications:

The Scouts have started using discord for troop communications among themselves. If your scout is under 13, you need to join under a parent account. The site is monitored and scouts who violate the rules will be removed. Use this link to join https://discord.gg/huTvzTHVk3. Scouts or adults who join need to be verified prior to seeing troop communications and scouts are assigned channels based on patrol, leadership position and rank.

Rules of the server are:

- 1. Follow the Scout Oath and Law
- 2. Use the channels as they are intended
- 3. Use scout appropriate language
- 4. If you would get in trouble doing it at a scout event don't do it here
- 5. Be respectful
- 6. Don't violate youth protection
