Dear Wolf Pack Students and Parents.

Attendance and behavior are a priority at West Hills High School. There is a direct correlation between student achievement, behavior, and attendance. Every day missed is a lost opportunity for students to learn. In addition, students who are assigned detention or other consequences for school violations must fulfill their consequences.

Students are placed on the Loss of Privilege (LOP) list if they have 25 or more LOP points within the current school year. Students receive LOP points for:

- Being tardy (unexcused)
- Period truancies (student should be in school and either willfully does not attend or there is no parent contact to the Attendance office within 3 school days of the absence).
- Failed to serve assigned detention(s)
- Had a significant behavior incident discussed with you by an Administrator

Is your student on the LOP list?

• Weekly emails are sent to parents and students if their student is on the LOP list. Students may check if they are on the LOP list at any time at bit.ly/whhs-lop

How can I view my student's attendance?

- Log into the Parent Portal at bit.ly/quhsdparentportal
- View attendance through the Infinite Campus phone app
- Turn on notifications through the Infinite Campus phone app
- Students will also be notified via email throughout the semester

Students on the LOP list risk being excluded from participation in extracurricular activities such as:

Prom, Athletics, Sporting events, or other school wide optional events (home or guest school)

How are LOP points calculated?

- One period tardy = 1 point
- One period truancy = 2 points

How do students get off the LOP list?

- A 30 minute detention = removes 1 point
 - Detention takes place on Monday thru Thursday in B-8
 - o 1st Period 8:30-9:15PM OR 7th Period 2:40-3:20PM
- A 4-hour Saturday School = removes 8 points
 - o Saturday School dates will be updated on page 2 of this document once scheduled

We encourage you to review your student's attendance regularly and help promote positive habits. Thank you for partnering with us in your student's education.
