## 2024 WIAA Regional Track & Field Meet

**Columbus, Grafton, Kettle Moraine Lutheran, Kewaskum, Lake Country Lutheran,  
Lomira, Mayville, Watertown Luther Prep, Waupun**

**DATE / LOCATION:** Monday, May 20th at Grafton High School. Field Events at 3:30 pm,  
Running Events at 4:15 pm.

### Participation Entries:

- All entries must be done by **Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am**. Entries are to be made via [WIAA D2 Grafton Regional 2024 - Meet Information \(milesplit.com\)](#).
- Each school is allowed a maximum of 3 entries per individual event/1 relay team per relay event contested.
- A school may enter a maximum of 28 individual entries (per gender team).
- A maximum of six students may be listed per relay. The same individuals must be retained through the entire postseason. Being listed as a relay member counts as one of the four events whether or not the school participates.
- All athletes will be allowed to compete in no more than 4 events (with at least one being a field or running event).

### Meet Management:

- Coaches' meeting will be held at **3:00 pm** under the south end of our home bleachers. Scratches only.
- All athletes should check in with the clerk upon the first call of that event. All races (except the 200m dash and 300m hurdles, which are clerked at the event start) will be clerked from the 100m dash, and athletes will be walked up the straightaway as the race finishes before the upcoming event.
- All spectators must remain out of the track area, behind fencing. This includes the throws area and the long jump/triple jump area.
- All results will be announced in a timely fashion and will be available after the meet concludes.
- WIAA Officials: Meet Referee: Frank Carini, Starters: Mike Riley and Larry Gardner
- Jury of Appeals: Mayville (boys' coach), Waupun (girls coach), Kevin Moore (meet manager), WIAA meet starters; WIAA Spring Regulations cover the job details of the jury.

### Field Events:

- Field events will begin at **3:30 pm**. At this time, we will run girls long jump, girls high jump, girls shot put, boys pole vault, boys triple jump, boy's discus. This will be followed by boys' long jump, boys high jump, boys shot put, girls pole vault, girls triple jump, and girls discus.
- All implements must be weighed in immediately upon arrival. Implements will be weighed in under the home bleachers at **3:00 pm**.

- Shot put and discus will be run in flights (specifics will be communicated at the coaches meeting). Warm-up throws in shot put and discus are allowed between flights for 10 minutes. After trials have completed, another 10 minutes of warm-up throws are allowed.
- Long jump and triple jump will be open pits for 1 hour with the top 9 qualifying for finals. Finals will begin 20 minutes after finalists have been announced. Finals will be in reverse order.
- In the high jump and pole vault, the starting heights shall be determined by counting down using the performance of the 8<sup>th</sup> best athlete, then subtracting two increments (4" HJ, 1' PV)
- In the high jump, the bar will be raised 2 inches each time until the final 6 jumpers, then 1 inch at a time.
- In the pole vault, the bar will be raised 6 inches each time until the final 6 vaulters, then 3 inches at a time.
- Vaulters must have weight verification forms complete or they cannot participate.
- A field judge must be present for warm-up throws and for the long and triple jump pits to be open.
- If a competitor needs to leave for another event, they must check out with the field judge. Check out will be 15 minutes.

### **Running Events:**

- Will begin at **4:15 pm**.
- Qualifying from prelims to finals will be the winner in each heat, plus the next fastest times from any heat until all available lanes are filled.
- All running event athletes will need a hip number. Athletes should get hip numbers from the table at the start of the 100m.

### **Facilities:**

- Concession stand and restrooms are on site adjacent to the track and home bleachers.
- Team camps will be allowed in the grass area to the west of the track as well as beyond the northeast corner of the track (near the soccer practice field).
- 8-lane track surface, ¼ inch spikes allowed. The long/triple jump and shot/discus area is located immediately east of the track.
- Buses may drop off near the main entry of the stadium (Kellner Field Archway), then park in the GHS east parking lot (see map).

### **Admission:**

- Tickets will be available via the GoFan ticketing app. Payment by card and/or Apple Pay will also be accepted.

### **Awards and Sectional Qualifying Procedures:**

- The top 4 individuals and relay teams will move on to the WIAA sectional.
- Plaques will be awarded to each 1<sup>st</sup> place team.

### **Athletic Trainer:**


- An Aurora-contracted athletic trainer will be on site and located next to the timing tent before, during, and immediately after the competition.
