Author's Purpose	Why did the author write the text? What lesson is meant to be learned?
Predict	What do you think will happen next (based on the pictures and clues in the text)?
Monitor	Ask questions and re-read for clarification.
Question	Ask questions to ensure the reader clarifies and understands what is happening in the text.
Summarize	Identify the main points of a text that are worth knowing and remembering.
Sequence	Understand the order of events within a text.
Connect	Make text to text, text to self, and text to world connections.
Visualize	Make pictures in your head based on what the text says.
