

Specific College Policies Regarding Undocumented / AB 540 Students

Notes:

These colleges were selected because they promise to offer mostly grant aid (free money!) and limited loans. However, some do not provide this assistance to AB 540 students. See the details for each college below. We are still waiting to hear from the college if no information is provided.

Current as of October 2009 – you are advised to contact your favorite colleges directly to make sure nothing has changed!

Amherst College	Massachusetts	Financial Assistance provided as long as honest on Admissions.
Arizona State University	Arizona	<u>No support provided</u>
Bowdoin College	Maine	Undocumented students are considered in the international students category and are awarded assistance based on need
Brown University	Rhode Island	Must apply as international student. If accepted, will meet need. BUT, admission for international students is “need aware” not need-blind.
Bryan College	Tennessee	Does not accept undocumented students
Carleton College	Minnesota	Limited aid available, considered international students
Colby College	Maine	Must apply as international student. Only 8 international students admitted a year. Rare for an undocumented student to qualify.
College of the Holy Cross	Massachusetts	Not eligible for any financial aid
College of William and Mary	Virginia	Only private loans
Columbia University	New York	Assistance for all admitted students. Must complete the CSS International Student Financial Aid Application. Admission is competitive.
Connecticut University	Connecticut	Must Apply as International Student (no information provided on financial assistance)
Cornell University	New York	Can be eligible for limited need-based aid for International students.
Dartmouth College	New Hampshire	Students are considered international, Must complete a CSS profile: NO FAFSA. The university meets full need of students with employment, scholarships and/or loans Admission is competitive.

Fairfield University	Connecticut	Must apply as international student. Does offer small amount of institutional aid. Need to complete CSS Profile and FAFSA. Counselor can write in on behalf of student to obtain an application fee waiver

Harvard University	Massachusetts	Undocumented students must file as international students. Guidelines at website: Harvard.edu. All aid is based on need. Admission is competitive.
Haverford University	Pennsylvania	Considered international student and eligible for full need-based financial assistance. Only three spots available. A summer savings is expected. Fee waivers available
Indiana University, Bloomington	Indiana	No financial aid assistance
John Carroll University	Ohio	Only merit aid is awarded. Money is limited.

Lehigh University	Pennsylvania	Considered international student for financial aid purposed. Aid is limited and competitive
Massachusetts Institute of Technology	Massachusetts	Considered International student, must submit CSS profile. Will meet full need-based aid. Can send a letter detailing special circumstances or unusual expenses to financial aid. Admission is competitive.
Miami University(Ohio)	Ohio	Eligible for merit-based scholarships

Northwestern University	Illinois	Only need-based financial assistance available if student applies as international students. Very competitive. Not eligible for application fee waiver
Oberlin College	Ohio	Students are considered international. Must complete a CSS profile: NO FAFSA
Princeton University	New Jersey	Full support provided! Admission is need-blind. Aid is awarded solely on basis of need. Need is met through grants, scholarships, other sources or campus jobs. Application fee waivers available. Admission is competitive.
Ripon College	Wisconsin	Eligible for merit-based scholarships. Can submit paper FAFSA to college and receive partial need-based assistance. (\$15,000-20,000),

Whitman College	Washington	Does provide need-based aid if admitted. Must apply as international students. Admission is competitive.
Yale University	Connecticut	Financial assistance based on need. Must apply as international student. Admission is competitive.

Azusa Pacific University	CA	Can apply for merit-based scholarships which are based on SAT and GPA
California Institute of Technology	CA	Need based aid given if admitted. Must apply as international student. Admission is competitive.
Claremont McKenna College	CA	Financial need is met if you are admitted. If they are unable to meet your need, admission is not offered. Expect students to have a summer savings of \$1,650. Must complete CSS profile and hardcopy of FAFSA
Pitzer College	CA	Offers one renewable scholarship (tuition, fees, room & board) for admitted AB540. Requirements are: not permanent resident or UC citizen and born in Latin American country, attended CA HS for 4 yrs, min. 3.5 GPA, extracurricular and leadership activities, must be nominated by HS counselor

Pomona College	CA	Offers aid to all students who graduated from a U.S high school. Expect a \$1,900 minimum family contribution (books & personal expenses). Must complete a CSS profile and submit tax returns and statements of earnings
Loyola Marymount University	CA	Eligible for merit-based scholarships only
Stanford University	CA	Students are met with full need and should apply as international students, But they will be considered domestic. School will meet student's full need. Admission is competitive.
Soka University	CA	Generous need and merit-based financial aid is available. Students are all required to study abroad for 1 year. <i>Students need a passport and visa for this requirement.</i>
University of California(system-wide)	CA	While the university cannot supply students with financial aid directly, each institution offers links for outside scholarships. Visit each school's website for the links.
University of Redlands	CA	No financial aid available, application fee waivers available
University of Southern California	CA	Considered international students. No need-based aid or application fee waivers, but merit scholarships available.
